New Swiss hires:

- ETHZ (CHIPP): hiring process at an advanced stage
- UniGe (CHAPS): stabilisation of A. Fragkos expected to be finalised next week
- UniGe (CHIPP): proposed stabilisation of S. Schramm, pending confirmation late 2024

Swiss community activities:

- GW-Learn Sinergia project has started (09/2023): brings together ET, LISA, ML, and theory - Organised first GW session at SPS in 2023; currently organising second edition for 2024
