


Location

- CERN hotel provides 450 rooms on three separate buildings + Saint-Genis hostel (151 rooms; bus to/from both CERN sites)
- Prices vary between 26 EUR/27 CHF to 64 CHF including shared rooms for students
- Around CERN several other hotels are available with prices starting from 60 CHF

 Two large restaurants at CERN main side + several cafeterias (R1 is open 7-22; R2: 7-17)


 A selection of five different daily dishes (fish, meat, pasta, vegan meal and pizzas)

News on CPOD2025+

- From last IAC meeting: the next CPOD to be at CERN by late 2025/early 2026
- Decision on dates was postponed to this meeting
- We propose the following date: 13-17 April 2026
 A little bit earlier dates are possible but fall 2025 is taken by the last Pb run at CERN before LS3; summer by proton run, Summer Student program and Hadronic Festival
- Main venue: pre-booked Council Room (there is still no schedule for 2026) and booked Kjell Johsen Auditorium as a backup
