



Lanzhou lies at the geographical heart of China and is the capital city of Gansu province; connected to Beijing, Shanghai via direct flights



# Who

- Institute of Modern Physics (IMP) is the largest nuclear physics research institute, under the Chinese Academy of Sciences (CAS); joint with CCNU.
- Heavy-ion collisions group ~10 faculties
  - Theory: QCD phase diagram
  - Experiment: STAR, CBM, CEE
- LOC:YiYin, Yapeng-Zhang (IMP) and Xiao-Feng Luo (CCNU)



IMP is constructing High-Intensity heavy ion Accelerator Facility (HIAF). CEE detector@HIAF: studying the QCD phase structure at high baryon density



IMP hosted 1st international High Energy Physics School/Workshop in Western China in 2018. Among 110 participants, 35 are international. IMP will host 20th XQCD, July 2024.

## Why Lanzhou, China

- Encouraging Chinese young generation to join the frontiers of QCD Phase diagram
- CPOD has never been held in person in Asia since 2011. Having one boosts the growth of international community


### When and how
