
Top risks from Security Risk Analysis

- Launch attacks on other sites
 - Large distributed farms of machines
- Illegal or inappropriate distribution or sharing of data
 - Massive distributed storage capacity
- Disruption by exploit of security holes
 - Complex, heterogeneous and dynamic environment
- Damage caused by viruses, worms etc.
 - Highly connected and novel infrastructure



(3) Security Collaboration in the LHC Grid



Enabling Grids for E-sciencl

- Incident Response improvement (ex: Incident response scenarii, Security Service Challenge, Incident tracking, Reporting channels, etc.)
- OSCT communications with other groups and the sites (ex: OSCT websites, Security RSS feed, training, etc.)
- Security tools (monitoring, detection, prevention)
 (ex: Pakiti, Security monitoring, etc.)

These activities have been divided into different tasks, which are spanned across the ROCs (See slide "(7) Tasks allocated to the regions")

Enabling Grids for E-sciencE

Main improvements during EGEE-II

- Team members are on rota to ensure timely response to operational issues
- ROCs are more involved in pan-regional activities and, as such, agreed during OSCT-2 (26/01/2007) on a list of tasks
- Security Service Challenges (SSC) remain very useful. Most of the ROCs are currently performing a SSC
- The team is now more cohesive
- Good participation to meetings (OSCT-2 and IM meeting)

But:

- Most ROCs are unable to deliver agreed efforts
- Several ROCs are unable to contribute to any activity other than the rota
