Annika Glauner has joined the ETH Zurich's team of Research Initiatives & Infrastructures in 2024. She is responsible for EOSC, ESFRI, Open Research Data and the RI Roadmap. From 2007 until 2024 Annika was the Head of International Research Policy and Strategy at the mutual grants office of ETH Zurich and the University of Zurich. She was as in charge of the artist-in-resident program at the Centre for Art and Media Karlsruhe Germany (ZKM) between 1993 and 2000 and part of the consortium defining a schemata for the Esprit Long-Term Research initiative 'Intelligent Information Interfaces' (i3). She worked as Senior Project Manager within the Strategic Design Group at Philips Design Eindhoven, Netherlands before she became artistic director of an international festival for film, video and new media in Basel, Switzerland in 2002.

Annika is a Steering Committee Member of a LERU policy group and Vice-Chair of NCURA's Steering Committee on Global Affairs.
