Biography

Prof. Luděk Matyska is a full professor at Masaryk University and the director of CERIT-SC, one of the three partners in the national large research e-infrastructure, e-INFRA CZ. He plays a key role in the Czech implementation of the EOSC initiative, serving as the chairman of the steering board of the strategic EOSC-CZ project, which oversees the EOSC implementation in Czechia. Prof. Matyska is also affiliated with CESNET, where he currently serves as the principal investigator of the National Repository Platform for Research Data project, aiming to establish the technological and service foundation of EOSC in Czechia.

Additionally, Prof. Matyska leads or oversees national teams in EC-funded projects related to EOSC implementation at the European level, such as EOSC-ENTRUST and AARC. His research interests revolve around security in large-scale distributed systems, esp. authentication and authorization, e-infrastructure architecture (network, computing, and data) and its efficient use.
