Natalia Galica is a member of the Open Science team at the National Science Centre Poland, where she carries out tasks related to research data management and open access publishing, including the provision of training for researchers and data stewards in Poland. In the EOSC Focus project, she is a Polish leader of engagement activities in the regional hub and cooperation with the Widening Countries. Since 2023 she is the national representative of Poland in the Council for National Open Science Coordination (CoNOSC) and a member of the advisory team to the Polish Minister of Science on national policy on open research data.

Natalia is also a researcher at the University of Silesia, where she was the Open Science Coordinator until 2022.

Natalia is a graduate of University College Dublin, University of Silesia and Data Stewards School. She is currently preparing a doctoral thesis on the politics of Open Science.
