Dr. Jochen Ortmeyer studied Chemistry in Paderborn (Germany) and received his PhD in Inorganic Chemistry at Paderborn University in 2016. After postdoctoral fellowships at the Max-Planck-Institut für Kohlenforschung (Mülheim an der Ruhr, Germany) and the University of Alabama (Tuscaloosa, USA), he joined the research group for Bioinorganic Chemistry of Prof. Sonja Herres-Pawlis at RWTH Aachen University (Germany) in 2020.

Since then, he has been project manager for the task area community involvement and training in NFDI4Chem (Consortium for Chemistry in the National Research Data Infrastructure (NFDI) in Germany). Furthermore, he coordinates the section training & education (Speakers: Prof. Sonja Herres-Pawlis and Prof. Peter Pelz), a department within the NFDI that brings together people from all consortia involved in training and education in research data management, and the DALIA project, which is developing a platform for training and teaching materials for research data management based on semantic web technology.
