Biography

Jan Hrušák is senior research fellow and scientific advisor on European science policy at the Czech Academy of Sciences, member of the Board for large research infrastructures and Special envoy for research infrastructures at the Ministry (MEYS). He completed studies in physical chemistry and received PhD (Dr.rer.nat) in 1987 at the Technical University Leuna-Merseburg (Germany), before joined the Institute of Macromolecular Chemistry of the Czechoslovak Academy of Sciences. In 1990 he moved to TU Berlin to work with H. Schwarz in theoretical chemistry. In 1995 accepted a position at the J. Heyrovský Institute of Physical Chemistry, where, after spending one year as visiting professor at the Institute of Molecular Science at Okazaki (Japan), he is working since. Jan Hrušák served two terms in the Academy Council - executive body of the CAS, and he has been appointed for two years DG for research at MEYS. He is member of ESFRI EB and Czech delegate to ERAC. He acted as expert appointed to the EOSC Executive board (2019-2020) and is now representing Czech republic EOSC Steering board, where he acts as the vice-cochair.
