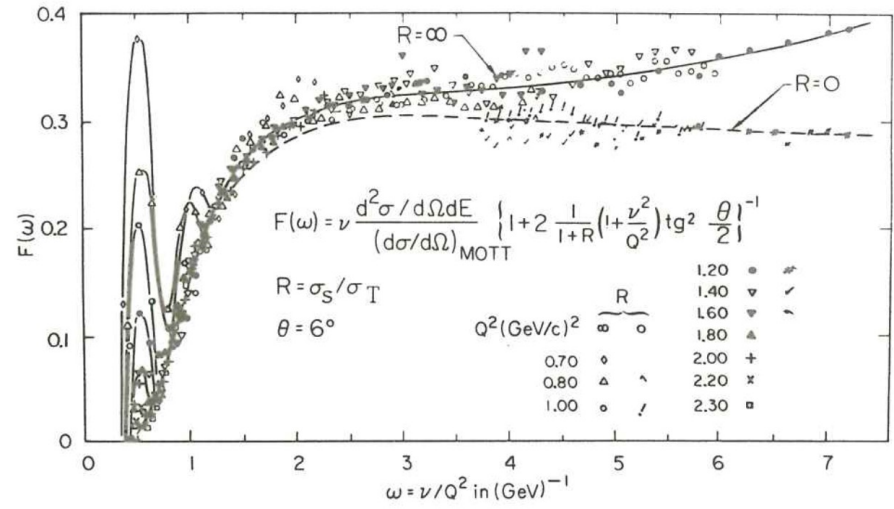

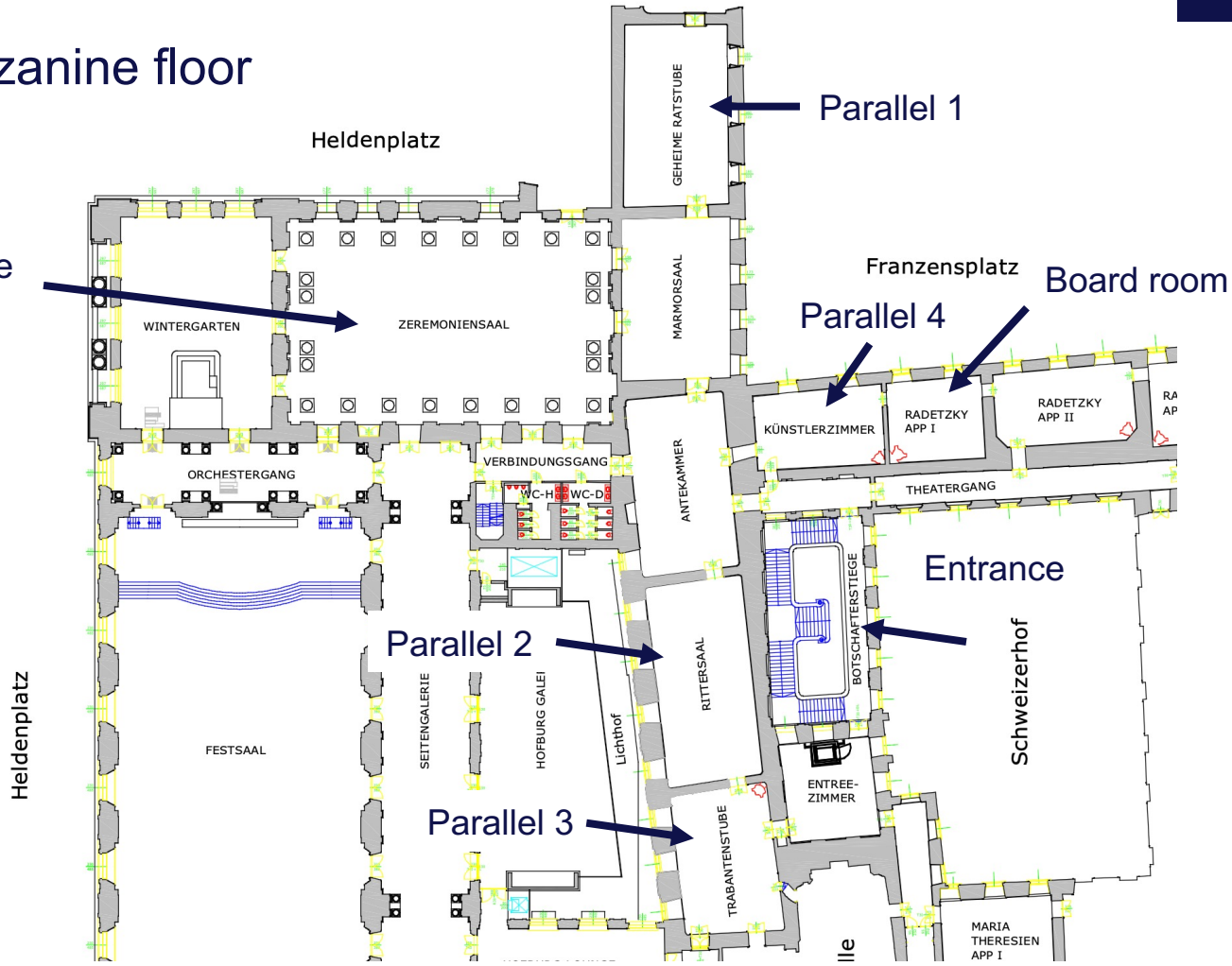


Evaluation of the integral over the SLAC data gives about 60% of the required amount. There is no visible quasi-elastic peak at a defined inelasticity $\nu = q^2/2m$, where m is some characteristic mass, but the apparent success of the parametrization of the cross-sections in the variable ν/q^2 in addition to the large cross-section itself is at least indicative that point-like interactions are becoming involved.
