## VPC migration

- All BE-CSS VPC running CentOS 7 will be shut down on the 20<sup>th</sup> of June at the latest.
  - In exceptional cases, it is possible to keep CentOS 7 for the time being.
- RHEL9 VPCs do not allow NFS access through /nfs/cwe-513-xxx/opt
  - This is for security reasons.
  - If you need this feature, contact the system administrators to modify this behaviour for your VPC.
  - You can also use your NFS home /user/<login> instead
- All the development and diagnostic tools should work on RHEL9.

## FESA news

- FESA 8.5.0 was released
  - GCC 11 on CentOS 7 can be used with this version

- FESA plug-in distribution will change
  - It will not be installed by default anymore (SDC license expiring)
  - It can be installed and updated manually in a few steps

  - If possible, we'll provide a script to install it automatically.
