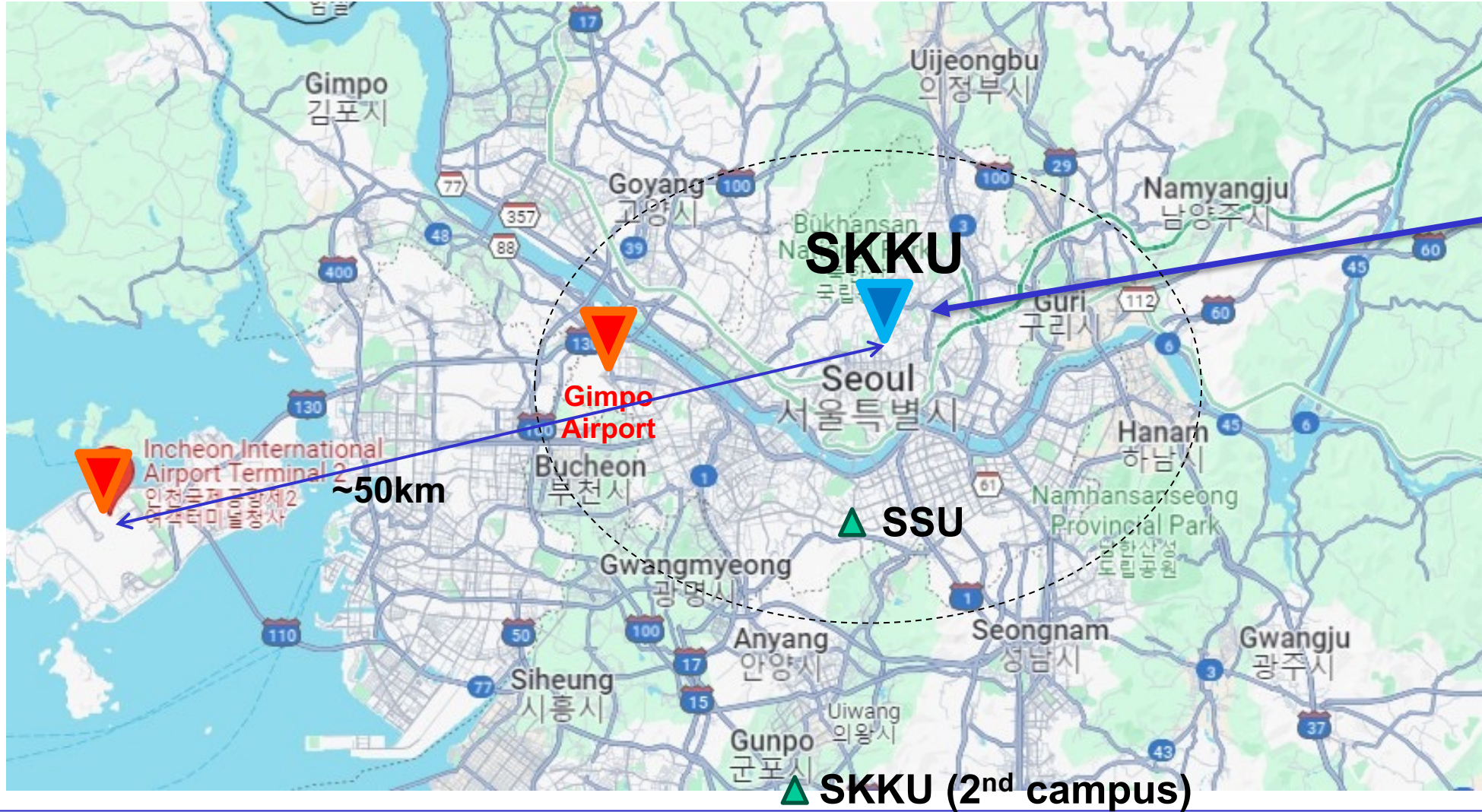
# Summary Slide

# Seoul: Basic Info and Access

- Seoul
  - Has been the capital city since 1394.
  - 10 million people inside the city boundary.
    - 26 million including Incheon and vicinity.
  - Geographically divided to
    - River North (including old town) and
    - River South
- Two international airports
  - Incheon Airport (ICN) is a major hub
    - 1 hour from the center of Seoul.
  - Gimpo Airport (GMP) provides intercity shuttles for Asia
    - ½ hour from the center of Seoul.

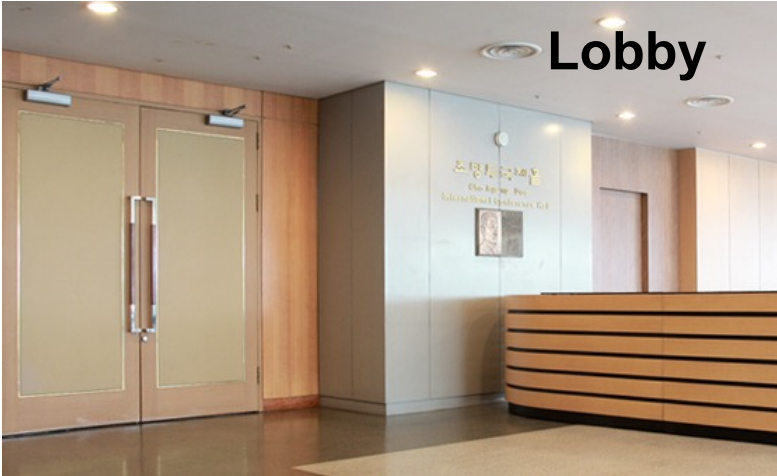

# Workshop Venue Candidates: Other Possibilities

- Reservation for 600 Anniversary Hall for the 2025 fall season starts on November 2024.
- Plan B in case reservation not possible
  - COEX main campus
    - 2018 ICHEP conference venue
    - Lots of amenities but expensive
    - Have to reserve facilities early.
  - COEX @ Magok
    - New facility scheduled to open November 2024
    - Near Gimpo Airport, next to the Airport Express Train to Center of Seoul.
  - Workshop spaces in other universities
    - More affordable compared to COEX
    - Usually fully booked during fall semesters.

# Hotels and Access to Campus

- Outside the campus is a residential area.
- Hyehwa Subway Station is 15 minutes on foot.
- However, the campus is on a hill. It is recommended to use a shuttle bus run by the University.
- Business or tourist hotels a couple of subway stations away. The price range is wide.
