Introduction

As stated in the preamble of the Collaboration MoU, IPPOG is a network of scientists, researchers, science educators, explainers and communication specialists active across the globe in outreach for particle physics. IPPOG's mission is to maximise the impact of education and outreach efforts related to particle physics.

The Forum composition is defined in the Article 5 of the MoU [1]. It consists of:

- Chairs and Coordinators
- Members Representatives
- Participants in IPPOG and/or local working groups and activities (as well as any other contributors to the execution of IPPOG's mission) designated by Members Representatives.

In order to provide a “snapshot” of the collaboration growth, update campaigns are now coordinated once per year by the Chairs and Scientific Secretary: all Representatives are asked in October to update their nominations, results are presented to the CB in November and used for a year.

All Forum member:

- Receive newsletters and informations by e-mail
- Are invited to register and contribute to Collaboration meetings, e.g. by reporting on success stories.
- Are welcome in all IPPOG activities and working groups.
- Are invited, at the beginning of the year, to register to be added to the Author List used for conferences talks and proceedings.

On the //ippog.org website, the list was organised by “boxes” which are also used in this document, as they give a better visual representation of the spread of the collaboration. It is important to note, however, that individuals may have several commitments, e.g. in experiments and countries.

The 2025 Forum List

The nominations presented in this document were collected between mid October and mid November 2024, and the list will be used in 2025. **It counts 183 persons.**

For comparison, the first major update campaign of this type lead to a 2024 list of 156 persons. Several Representatives replied that they needed time to think about their strategy, given the diversity of local activities. This time:

- Several “empty boxes” were filled by nominations,
- New Representatives were added to the list while their predecessor remains a forum member,
- Experiments host few more colleagues, active for long but whose country is not (not yet?) in IPPOG.

The 2025 Author List registration campaign will start in February, and the list will be presented to the spring CB meeting. Last year, 83 colleagues out of 156 replied positively and were included in the Author list [2].
