8. **Custom Star Map:** Create a custom star map that shows the constellations on the night of your wedding day or another significant moment.
9. **Time Capsule:** Create a time capsule with mementos from the past ten years and notes to your future selves to open on a future anniversary.
10. **Couple's Classes:** Sign up for a cooking, pottery, or dance class to learn something new together and create lasting memories. **(PI meeting)**

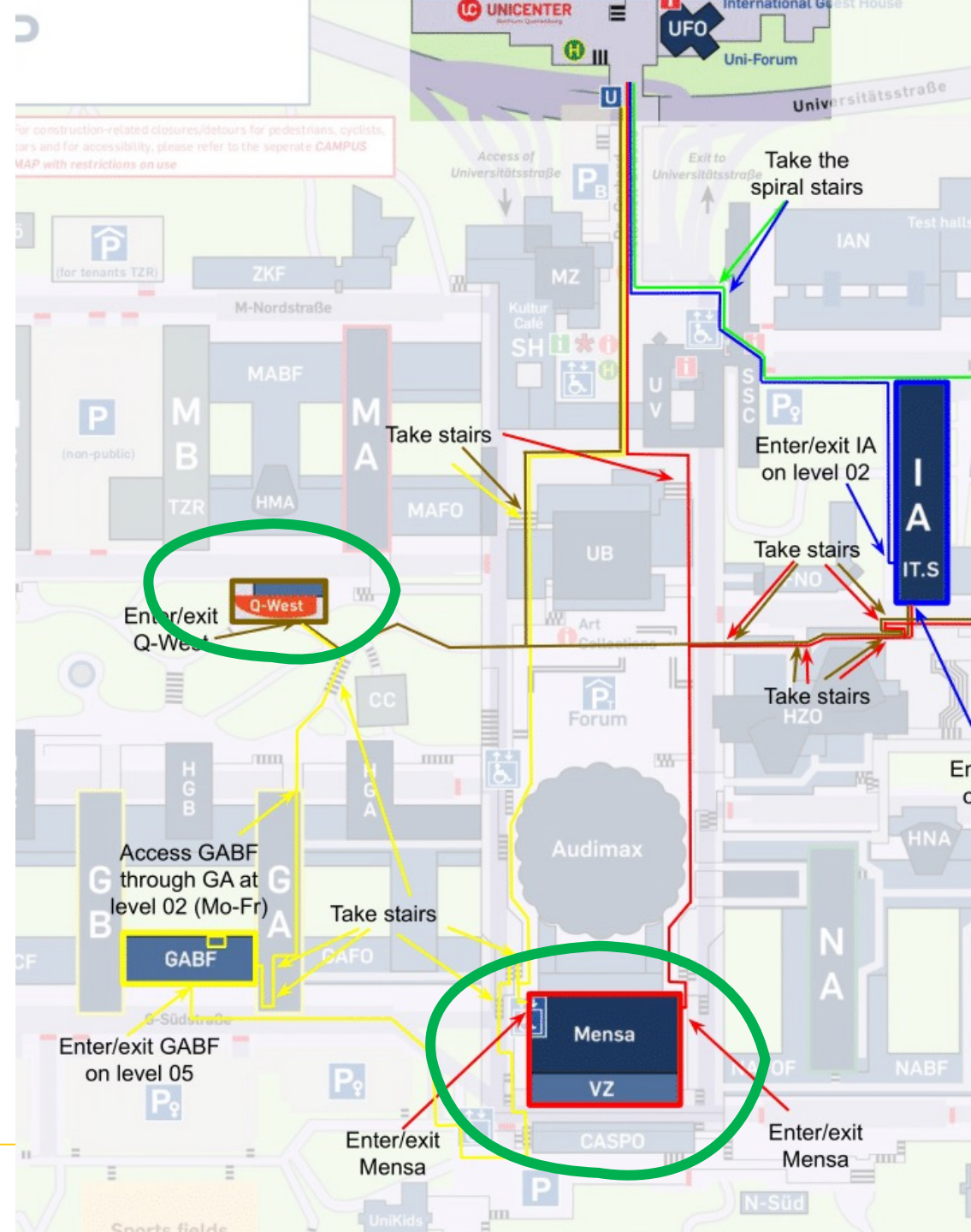

- Cannot pay cash (credit card or AKAFÖ card)



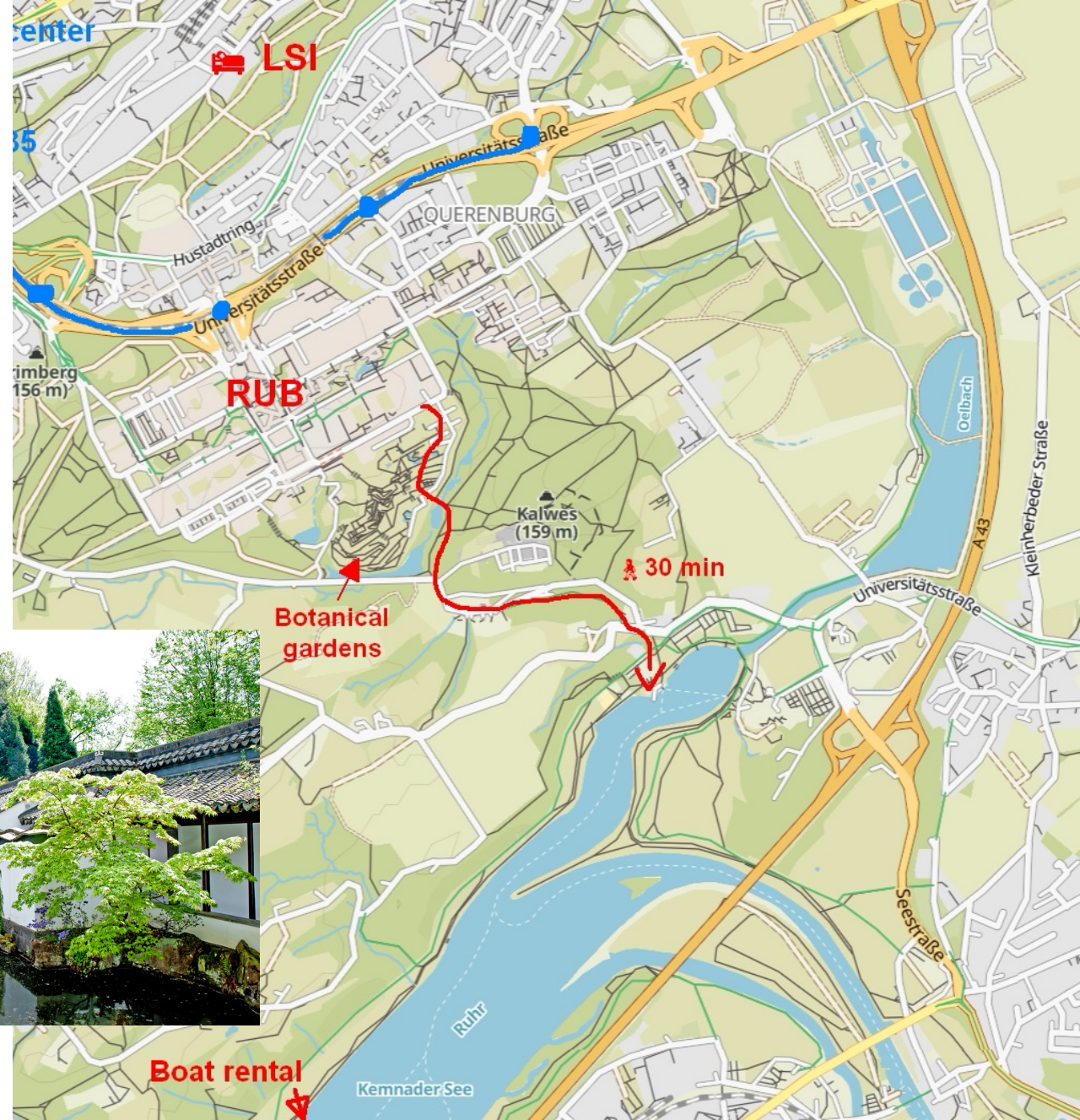
Evening program
