Submit an abstract

Clicking on “*Add myself*”, adds you as *Author* only. You must indicate a **speaker** by clicking the little microphone icon.

If you are **not** the speaker, or conversely, not the sole author, you **must add another person** by searching or entering manually, and indicate their role(s) as well.




