



- Produce a series of EGEE-specific roadmaps and deliverables to plan for the long-term sustainability of the EGEE infrastructure
- Establish links with other projects and initiatives including among others application, national, regional and related infrastructure projects
- Monitor EGEE-II contributions to standardisation activities
- Coordinate licensing issues => refer to the business talk



Towards Sustainability

Road towards EGI

- Distributed NGI/EGI questionnaire; 26 countries responded
- Presented results in NGI workshop in EGEE'06 conference
- Worked on consolidating the questionnaire results and defining NGI status
- Worked on planning for the EGI Design Project
- Organised EGI Workshop, February 26 27, Munich.

Work on Policies

Collaboration with the e-IRG

- A version of the e-IRG White Paper resulting from the Austrian presidency was published
- Chapters (co-)authored by EGEE members
- Extensive comments from EGEE members incorporated
- Helped organise:
 - e-IRG meeting and workshop, Helsinki, 4 5 October 2006
 - e-IRG meeting, Helsinki, 20 November 2006
 - e-IRG workshop, Heidelberg, 19 20 April 2007
- Transition to permanent co-chair model
- Significant input to e-IRG bylaws: EGEE is to get an observer seat in e-IRG










Liaising with Other Projects

- RPs information stand at User Forum

- e-IRG makes the transition from a single rotating presidency model to a permanent co-chair model
- e-IRG adopts bylaws
