

He received PhD with honors at Kapodistrian University of Athens (2010). He is a member of the RADIOSURGERY Board of Ministry of Health, Vice president of Hellenic Neuro-Oncology Society (HeNOS) and Head of Hellenic Radiosurgery Group, organized the first International Radiosurgery Congress in Greece (2023) under aegis of ISRS (International Stereotactic Radiosurgery Society). Participating in lectures about SRS in post-doc programs in Athens and Thessaloniki University medical schools, he is an invited speaker in International Congresses and Courses for Radiosurgery. Remains active in research, focusing on Radiosurgery of Skullbase Benign Tumors, member of the "Brain Tumor Group" of EORTC and ISRS. Nicolas Foroglou, MD, PhD, IFAANS is appointed as Professor of Neurosurgery in the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Greece and holds the Chair of The Department of Neurosurgery in the University Hospital. He has graduated from the Medical School of the same University (1993), fulfilled his military service in the Air Force General Hospital (1995) and served his community medical service in the highlands of North Greece (1996). He obtained the postgraduate Diploma of Clinical Neurology from the University College of London (Institute of Neurology, National Hospital for Neurology and Neurosurgery, Queen Square, UK) (1997) and completed the Residency Program in the Neurosurgical Department, AHEPA University Hospital (1997-2001). His PhD thesis focused on Immunochemistry of Recurrent Pituitary Adenomas was defended in the Aristotle University School of Medicine (2001). After being certified from the National Neurosurgical Examination Board and the European Association of Neurosurgical Societies (EANS) (2001), he did a research

fellowship on neuro-oncology (Brigham & Women Hospital, affiliated hospital to Harvard Medical School, Boston, USA) (2002) and a fellowship in Functional Neurosurgery (University Hospital of Lausanne, Switzerland) (2003).

He was elected unanimously as Lecturer of Neurosurgery at the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki, Assistant Professor in 2010, Associated Professor in 2016 and full Professor in 2019. His clinical and research activities are focused on neuro-oncology, brain mapping, epilepsy surgery and vascular surgery. He has published more than 70 papers in peer reviewed international journals, authored 12 chapter book and deliver more than 200 international lectures. He has been invited in numerous national societies and has been member of the editorial board of "Spinal Cord" and "World Neurosurgery", chief-editor of the official journal of the Hellenic Neurosurgical Society and reviewer for all important journals of the field.

He holds multiple memberships including EANO, EANS, AANS, CNS, Societe de Neurochirurgie de langue francaise, Hellenic Neurosurgical Society. She completed her Ph.D. Dissertation, an English-language master's degree in Medical research methodology and a post-doctoral research from the AUTH.
