

### **DRD1 AWARDS**



Following the proposal presented at the June Collaboration Meeting (WG8), DRD1 is pleased to announce the establishment of the DRD1 AWARDS initiative.

This program aims to support, foster and provide larger visibility to R&D and "blue-sky" researchers in the field of gaseous detector for particle physics, and beyond.

## **AWARDS Categories**



# PhD Thesis Award for exceptional contribution to developments in the field of gaseous detectors

- PhD completed within 2 years at the time of the closing of the call (thesis must have been defended already)
- Evaluation criteria based on:
  - **₽** CV
  - Publication related to thesis focus
  - PhD thesis
- Early Career Scientist Award for outstanding scientific developments in the field of gaseous detectors
  - = 7 years (excluding demonstrated career interruptions) after PhD at the time of the closing of the call
  - Evaluation criteria based on:
    - CV and publications
    - Scientific contributions during PhD
    - Tools developed/outstanding achievements
    - Leadership in experimental projects
    - Grants obtained/managed
    - Training and tutoring activities

## **AWARDS Categories**



- Exceptional Contributions to the DRD1 Collaboration Award (not necessarely every year)
  - Named by the Awards Committee and not by candidacy
  - No constraint on career stage
  - Evaluation based on exceptional contribution to DRD1 goals and mission

#### **AWARDS Selection Committee**



- DRD1 Scientific Coordinations Board
- Senior experts in the DRD1 Collaboration
- **₽DRD1 Spokespersons**
- For PhD Thesis Award, a selection of the Selection Committee members is chosen to read the full theses and provide a report for the rest of the committee, who decides collegially the award winner in a meeting

#### **NOMINATIONS**



- The candidate can be nominated by a Member of the collaboration (or by her/his thesis Advisor(s) in case of the PhD Theses Awards)
  - Candidacies must be accompanied by a support letter (not necessarily from DRD1 Members) explaining the nominee's qualifications and scientific achievements and motivating the proposed award with a short text.

## **AWARDS Application OPEN CALL**



#### For PhD Thesis and for Early Career Scientist Awards

- Nomination Period: Open until June 30th.
- Selection and Review Process: Completed by October.
- Winner Announcement: During the Collaboration Meeting in November/December, with the winner(s) invited to present their work.

#### **PRIZES**



- A certificate of the Award
- Presentation of the awarded work at the following DRD1 Collaboration Meeting
- Mention in DRD1 website and dedicated article in DRD1 Newsletter
- Possibility to present a contribution on behalf of DRD1 Collaboration at international conferences (if presentations on behalf of DRD1 will become a reality)
- Depending on CB confirmation and DRD1 funding availability, money prize and support for travel to present at DRD1 Collaboration Meeting
