## Experiences from a Collaborative Workshop

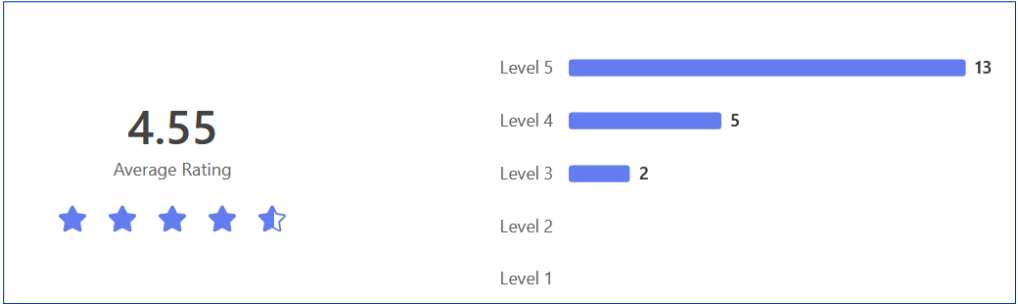
- Inspired from existing collaborative workshops like Climate Fresk
