### The Baobab Festival




With the rich learnings from Guinee, me and some friends started a band, and together we decided to organise a small concert where all income would be saved for higher reasons in Guinee. We invited fellow artists and 3 weeks later we held a concert called "Baobab Festival". In this night, apart from enjoying a beautiful event, we managed to save 1400 euro, and with this money in my shoes I travelled back to Africa in order to do something with this.

### **Baobab School**



Arriving in Guinee I realised that almost all the children in the village was without education, there where plenty of educated teachers but without work, and a small local was available. Speaking with one of the teachers we decided that we wanted to change the situation together, thus we rented the local, started to make school benches, buying schoolmaterial, and a couple of months later we could open the doors for 20 students in our first classroom. Even many of the parents came and wanted to take part of the education, so we decided to hold classes for children in the daytime and for adults in the afternoons.

### More education needed



Yet still we would realise we had only begun, and there was and is still a huge need for education, very well illustrated on this photo, where everone tries to take part in the classes.

### Project is growing



Coming back to Europe showing friends and surroundings what we had started got BIG positive reaction. Artist, volonteers, companies started to call and offering their service, and soon we would see the Baobab Festival be growing bigger and bigger. All with volontary time and effort.

At this point today the organisation Positive Footsteps are now 28 in numbers and increasing, all with different qualities, background, etnicity, contacts, but with one great vision connecting us.

## The situation today



In the same pace, the Baobab School is also growing, and the latest calculated number of students was 150, divided by 6 classes and 7 teachers.

As the interest of external parties also has been growing we can now say that Baobab School is looking to be selfsufficent soon. Thus we are now opening the door for projects in more countries, looking at both Gambia and Ghana.
