## Project M<sup>gt</sup>: How to learn from mistakes, taking advantages from them?

## **Principles**

Don't leave gathering lessons to the end of the project, but start a lesson learned log on day-1.

People will experience from the beginning and will integrate the exercise as a normal phase. It is moreover easier to log them as opportunities happen for a real-time benefit to be expected.

Lessons are often forgotten, and some mechanisms are necessary to refresh knowledge.

When putting a new project in place, listing previous lessons on similar project should / could be a part of starting phase.

Too much lessons to be considered will produce Less effect. Concentrate on the main ones, keeping them to less than 10.

Lessons must contains specific, realistic, practical pieces of advice.

Lessons must conclude with recommended positive actions.

Lessons must be free from references to individuals.

How to collect the lessons learned?	
Step	Actions
1	<b>Select the participants.</b> Don't invite everybody, if you know in advance that some people will not integrate well the exercise.
2	<b>Make sure you've got the data easily available:</b> project status report or presentation, milestone plans, or other visual documents.
3	<b>Be clear about who the lessons are aimed at.</b> Consider how you will influence the kind of lessons you want to capture.
4	Put in place the mode and way to collect relevant events, ideally in brain storm mode at first, and more analytic later, and which criteria must be taking into account: time / quality / money / people impact / operation / stress
5	Identify successes and failures, and collect them, first, all of them, without digging in details for the why it was good or bad.
6	Investigate the reasons why events happened as they did, with root cause analysis for example. Agree what you / should do the same / different / better next time.
7	Develop the lessons to be learned.  Make sure everybody agrees on it.  Write them focusing on specific, realistic, pratical advices, always in positive actions and recommendations.  Remove any indication of individual (name)
