### ROG and Linux News

- Clarification on availability of ROG
  - Nodes will be restarted at the end of december or SysAdmin days (to be decided by TIOC beginning of November)
  - The restart will kill the session of the person connected on the node, but a new session can be open immediately (on another node)
  - The restart of the nodes is therefore rolling, i.e. nodes are not restarted all at once
  - The SLA of ROG has always been to allow the session creation but not necessarily to maintain the session
- Two FA will start to implemented on backend servers (c.f. slide) with the ones connected between GPN and TN first
