Summary of Main Points Today

Token Session:

- There is a lack of consensus about token lifetime and scope as well as the service model and impacts on data taking in HL-LHC.
- The tape REST API is a crucial functionality that needs more discussion, perhaps in February.
- There is a scalability concern for access token handling in IAM and concerns about the IAM effort support level going forward.

CernVM:

- Need an evaluation of Varnish as a possible replacement for Squid including a plan for deployment
- Open questions about the scalability of CVMFS, Shapshooter as a possible new functionality, and the usefulness of hot patching.
