What we plan for the whitepaper

- Results from a (carefully crafted) survey
 - Ranked list of criteria for future collider choice
 - Other questions: importance of international collaboration, project size etc.
 - Concrete questions on future collider proposals

The Survey

- Timeline:
 - Start: very soon
 - End: early/mid January
- Criteria to be ranked by point allocation:
 - Sustainability: minimise environmental impact
 - Time to first physics collisions
 - Location* (might have to specify that this is implied in Europe/CERN)
 - Public / Social acceptance (e.g. cost, land use)
 - Stable support for smaller projects
 - Open to world-wide collaborations
 - Technological innovation driver
 - Baseline physics programme (without upgrades)
 - Clear upgrade path
