- Reporting only the main SA2 points agreed and discussed during the SA1+SA2 and SA2 sessions.
- Not reporting and repeating the actions and comments already presented or agreed in the plenary sessions

- POLICIES
 - Changes for multiple platforms to policies, dashboards, reports
 - All platforms in one single task for release changes to trackers
- ETICS
 - Central place updated to tell which client to use for each build
 - How to set up a local build node fully configured, how to get locally non-standard versions of the client
 - How to use your own spec file with ETICS
 - Mock build option used should be available to the users
 - Generation of multiple rpm implemented and documented
 - How to insert custom scripts in the ETICS execution (post-install, pre-remove scripts, etc)

- TESTBEDS
 - Clarify probes on the testbed and integration with EGI
 - Clarify RC installation and Testing repository on the testbed
 - Multiple platforms on the testbed (Tools? Frozen VM?)
- Metrics and QC
 - Immediate RfC for Arc and Unicore are not really immediate
 - Severity gLite unset in MANY RfC
 - Regression testing for high priority bug “associated test” will become mandatory
 - Start adding QA tasks for PTs in EMT tracker (with ok from RM)
 - Security training is going to be needed
 - Rplint: current status
