Messaging Solutions Recommendations



- No clear winner but clear recommendations
 - -Use STOMP
 - -Avoid vendor lock-in
 - -Isolate messaging components
 - Use dedicated messaging services made of independent brokers
 - —Test, benchmark and validate your use cases
 - Real environment matters!


Software vs Service



- Messaging software needs to be deployed on servers to provide a messaging service
 - -Just like many other services: web, database, ...
- Different messaging services are available
- Test
 - —EMI should have one as part of SA2
 - -CERN has one *dev* service
 - You can always deploy your own for specific needs
- Production
 - —EGI operates a service with four brokers
 - -WLCG operates two dedicated messaging services

Software




 Messaging brokers and client libraries are already available (open source software)

 - -Libraries to ease messages manipulation
 - Reusable basic blocks to isolate messaging dependent code
