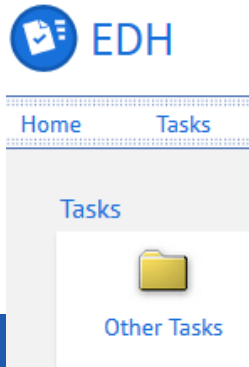


CERN Car
