## Indico@ MLZ


- Running Indico since 2012
- Migration from  $1.x \rightarrow 2.x \rightarrow 3.x$
- ~500 events of differenct scale up to now
- Deployment modernized over the years
  - Initially: VM with direct installation, run from a relativly frequently updated git version
  - Current: Dockerized version, build of git main branch with a few customizations
    - Separate images for webservice and celery
    - Custom multistage build to avoid rebuilding TeXlive too often
  - Planned: move to Kubernetes




# Our git status







## **Custom app**











### Challenges

- Currently no access to federated logins (EDUGain,...) due to complexity of our university IT
- Some users mix up our indico accounts with the CERN indico accounts (even so I already adjusted the template to make the distinction clear)
- Our typical layouts often require custom css to get the header nice (it would be nice to have an option to switch to an image-display only header with a single click instead)



### Challenges

- Payment is tricky due to no access to direct payment services
- Custom export implemented via plugin
