




ACTIVITIES IN THE LAST AND NEXT WEEK



- Lifting points on the detector were re-installed yesterday by G.Avoni and B.Diedzic (IMPACT 246346)
 - Thanks to the shielding moderate radiation to personnel (13 & 10 μ Sv)
 - The detector can now be hooked again with the overhead crane (repaired in December thanks to transport)
- Next activities on Monday
 - Crane testing
 - Disconnection of the detector on the side where we will start the removal on Tuesday (8-1) using the shielding
 - To be coordinated with transport to avoid conflicts (discussion w/ Serge via email)
- Removal of the detector on Tuesday Wednesday (one side per day)
 - IMPACT including ZDC, BRAN, Transport and RP: IMPACT 246601





MORE DETAILS ON TUESDAY



- BRAN needs to be disconnected before the removal of ZDC or on Tuesday before the craning
- If both the detectors are disconnected on Monday:
 - Start on Tuesday directly w/ the craning
- Otherwise
 - Accommodate ~30 min on Tuesday to disconnect ZDC and BRAN before the craning
- After de-installation & copper bar re-installation, we will need ~15-20 minutes to re-group the cables, prepare them (and take documentation) for the next installation during TS1
 - De-installation team of 5 people in total rotations to ensure no large amount of radiation accumulated on individuals
- Transport of the detector from SD1 to B180 end of Week 6 / early Week 7
