January FCC physics week:

- Target audience / actors = young scientists. Argue that they are great but do not have much time and may benefit from a transmission of experience + a framework

- Masterclasses are not relevant for their short/medium term needs, a open portal on activities and/or success stories like workshops co-organised with their young scientist community would be (TBC).
