

## Dear Participants of the UHECR2012 Symposium,

Thank you very much for your registration and for participating in the Symposium!

Because of the large number of participants, the meeting will be in the CERN auditorium except for Wednesday afternoon.

Below please find important instructions. Please read them carefully.

### For speakers:

Please have your talk readily available on memory stick before the sessions. We prefer pdf-format. Powerpoint and keynote documents are acceptable as well, as long as no special fonts are used. Important:

*Please note that the primary goal of the meeting is to discuss challenges of future UHECR observations, both in terms of physics as well as in terms of technological challenges to be addressed. We expect you to address such points.*

### For poster presenters:

We will have the posters in front of the main auditorium where also coffee will be served. The size of the posters is A0. The poster boards are made of a large metal grid, i.e. posters can be fixed easily with scotch tape. Please bring some yourself.

### How to enter CERN:

Participants arriving during the **weekend** can pick up their name badges from the security guard at Entrance B. The guards will have a list of participants and will have a name badge for them. You may need to identify yourself.

People arriving on **Monday** will have to enter CERN through Building 33 where one of us will be present to issue the badges.

### Those who stay at the CERN Hostel:

Those of you who have booked the CERN Hostel (a booking confirmation has been sent by us recently), go to the registration desk in the Hostel (Building 39) to receive your key. The registration desk is open from 9 AM to 1 AM.

### Those who stay in the Business Park Hotel:

Those of you who have booked the Business Park Hotel in France (a booking confirmation has been sent by us recently) can use a free shuttle bus for the pick-up and the drop-off between Business Park Hotel, Geneva airport and CERN, under reservation and availability. The **shuttle reservation needs to be done 24h in advance** at the latest.

For every pick-up at the arrival, the Hotel will need the estimation time of arrival and the flight number. The shuttle will be at the gate number 4, arrival section of Geneva Airport.

The Hotel offers a regular free shuttle to CERN. It will stop at the main entrance (entrance B). Please kindly notice that they have 2 shuttles, 8 seats per each. The ride will take only 5 minutes from CERN, they will go as often as needed to give all people a quick ride.

We shall open the registration desk on Monday 10:00 AM. You will find it near the auditorium: Bat. 61, 1st floor, Room 007. Those of you who did not yet pay the fee need to do so in cash at the

registration desk. There is a Swiss Bank in the same building, just a minute from the meeting venue.

We will have a **Welcome Reception** in the CERN globe on Monday evening with the opportunity to visit the exhibition and see the video/audio show. On Wednesday evening we will have a **Conference Dinner** in the Geneva area. Both are included in the conference fee including transport to the restaurant.

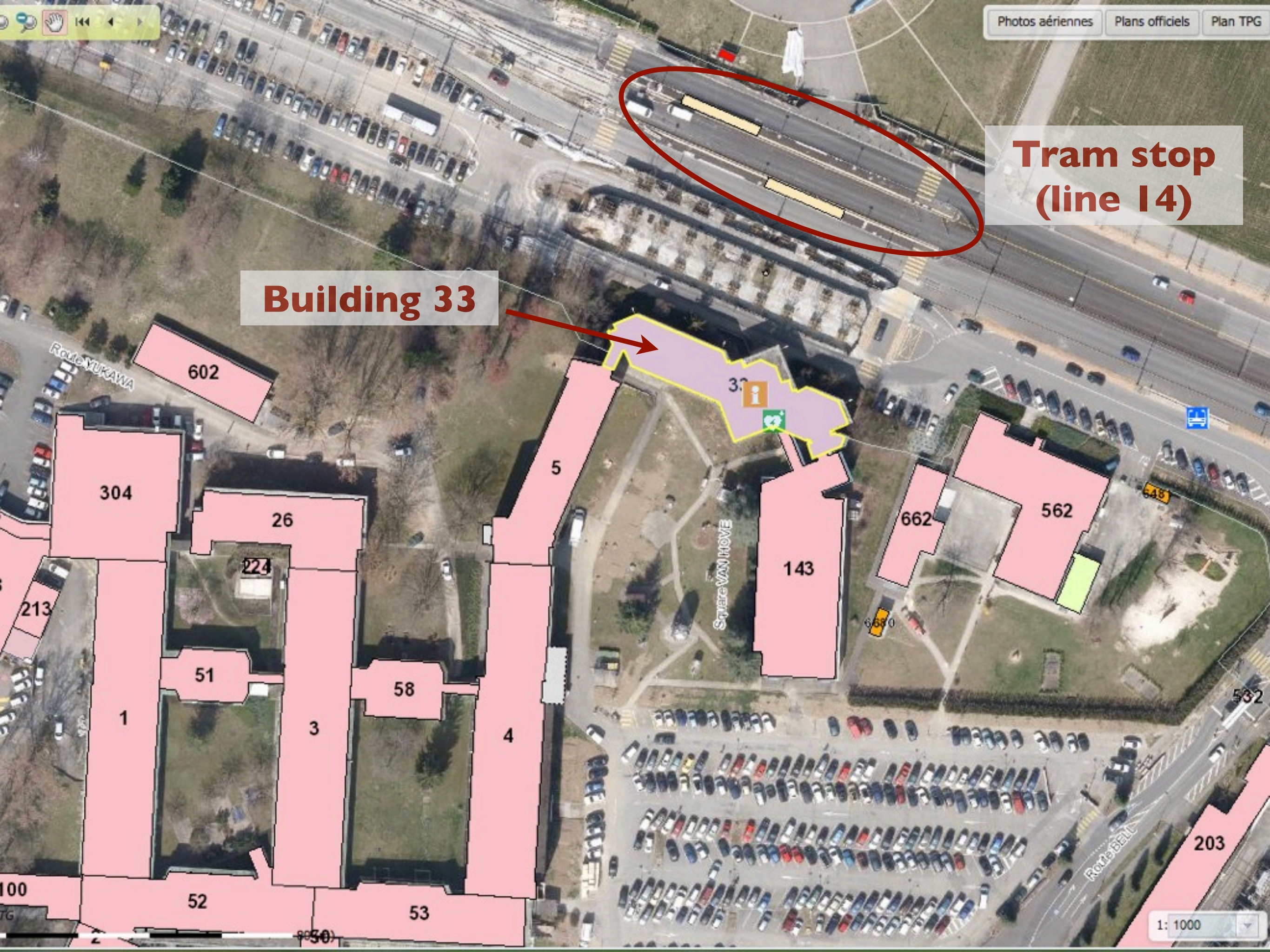
