

A Brief History of the University of Mississippi

Founded in 1848 with many students studying Latin

1856: Frederick A. P. Barnard becomes Chancellor

1859: Barnard Observatory built to study double star masses.

1860: Barnard gives glass to Alvin Clarke for telescope

31 Jan 1862: Graham Clarke finds white dwarf Sirus B.

10 Feb 1862: Discovery confirmed by Harvard

1864-1889: Barnard leads Columbia College.

1950: UMiss postmaster Faulkner wins Nobel Literature Prize

2011: UC-Berkeley Nobel Prize, white dwarf supernovae
