Open new lines of communication

- No direct communication between EGI and PTs
 - EMI acted as a proxy for the communications
 - Requirements
 - Vulnerabilities and critical bugs
 - Release schedule dissemination
- EMI provided coordination
 - Synchronization between PTs updates
 - Control of backward (in)compatibilities
 - Test of updates coming from EPEL

- Lightweight coordination activity
 - Mailing list, wiki pages
 - Periodic phone meetings (every 2 weeks)
- Why?
 - Keep some of the coordination work done within EMI
 - Keep active communication channels between PTs
 - Open communications between EGI-UMD and PTs
 - *Keep releasing quality software in UMD*
- Who?
 - Product teams representatives, or groups of PTs representatives
 - Independently from having or not direct commitment with EGI and UMD
 - Representatives from UMD software provisioning team

What is in-topic?

- Coordination of the **UMD** software provisioning
 - Disseminate the UMD updates release schedule
 - Disseminate the status of products in the UMD software provisioning pipeline
 - Discuss the UMD QC document
- Gathering of development and release plans from the PTs
 - Focus on backward incompatibilities and changes in shared components
 - Coordinate releases when changes may disrupt depending products
- Track the status of critical requirements/bugs
 - Vulnerabilities and urgent bugs
- Discussion of the changes in the UMD repository structure and the workflows and tools available for the PTs
 - UMD repositories relation with other repositories

- Coordination of individual PT development activities
 - PT will have their own release cycles
 - Prioritization of requirements implementation
 - URT will *track* the status of critical requirements
- High level strategy planning
 - Topics for TCB or MEDIA
- Non technical discussions
