# Next steps

- Set up an editing team to pull together the output of the TEGs into an overall strategy document
- Encourage the TEGs to deliver their reports asap – even pre-reports by section
  - These don't need to be polished prose!
  - All will be publically available
- Call out areas where it is clear further work needs to be done
  - Either as continuation of the TEG or
  - As a dedicated (short term) focused wg → see GDB



# Editing team

- The idea is:
  - To work with the TEG reports and the TEG chairs to integrate the ideas,
  - Not to invent strategy
  - To point out holes, areas for more work
  - To bring to the MB the areas where recommendations have been made to discuss what actions to take
  - To produce a coherent strategy that we are all happy with
- Timescale: as soon as possible, but importantly by CHEP
  - Will report to OB in March on progress



# What does this team do?

- Create an overall framework for the reports:
  - An extended executive summary
- Deal with overlaps in topics between groups
- Point out holes, unanswered questions
- Collect the recommendations
- First draft of priorities
- Present the summary to the MB for action
