Currently, it is engaged in solving the infrastructure of the project EGEE-II "Enabling Grids for E-sciencE-II" with the goal to constitute the paneuropean Grid infrastructure. The institute is integrated in setting the national Grid Initiatives of the EU which intend to be responsible for building and supporting the E-science in the European countries. II SAS is authorized by the Ministry of Education to coordinate the establishment of the Slovak Grid Initiative and to manage its integration with other national Grid Initiatives.
