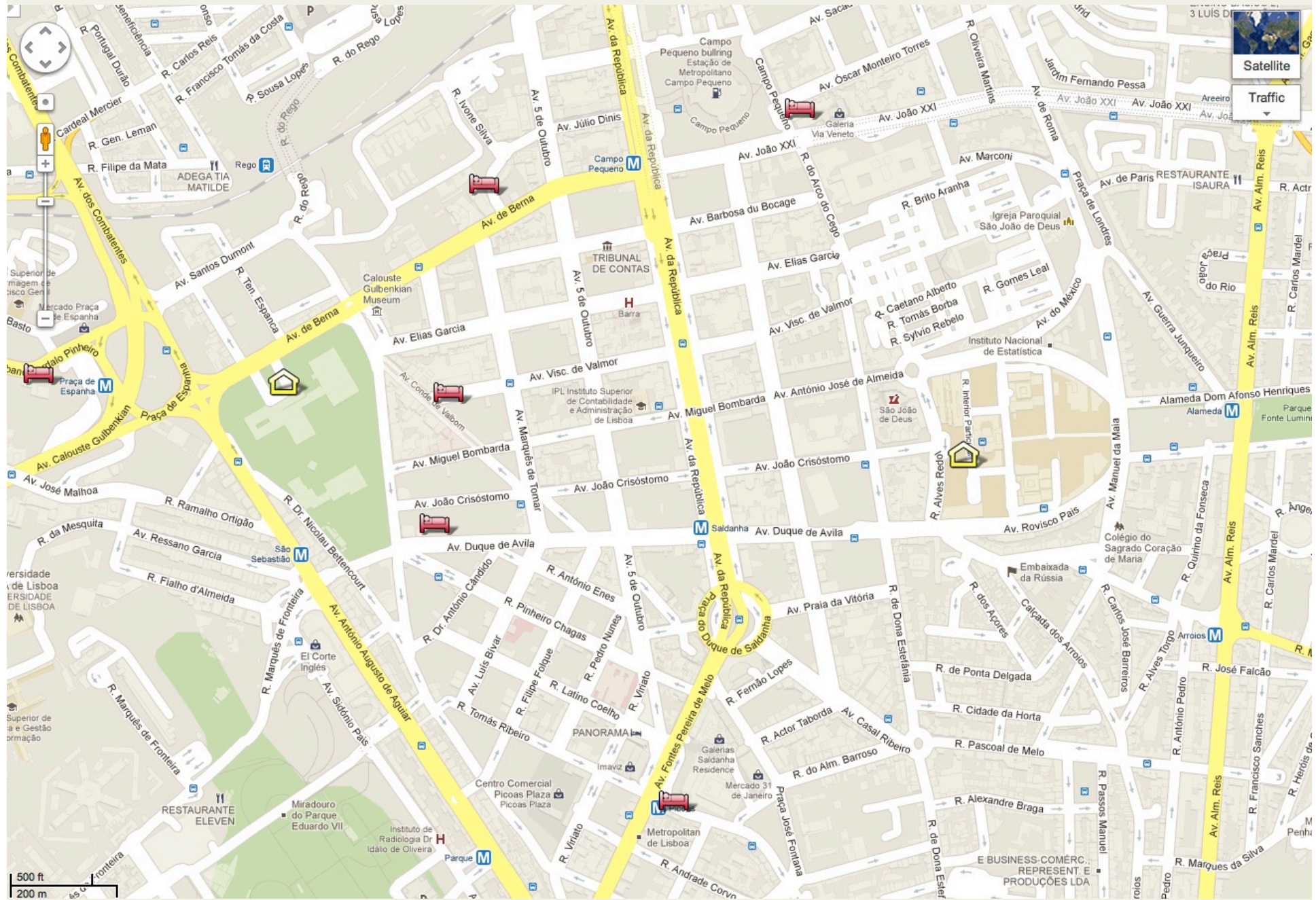

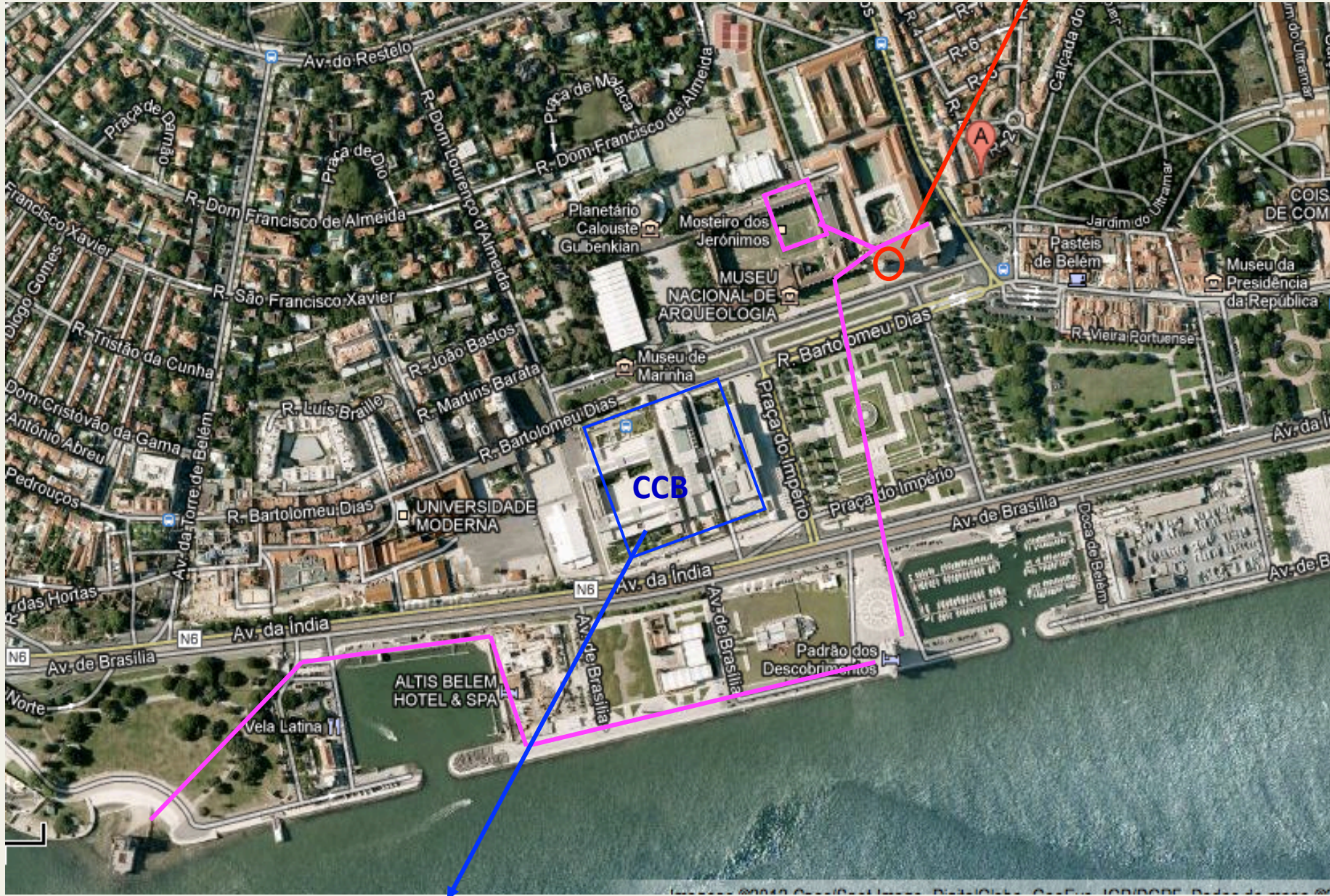


Metro Lines



Excursion Tour

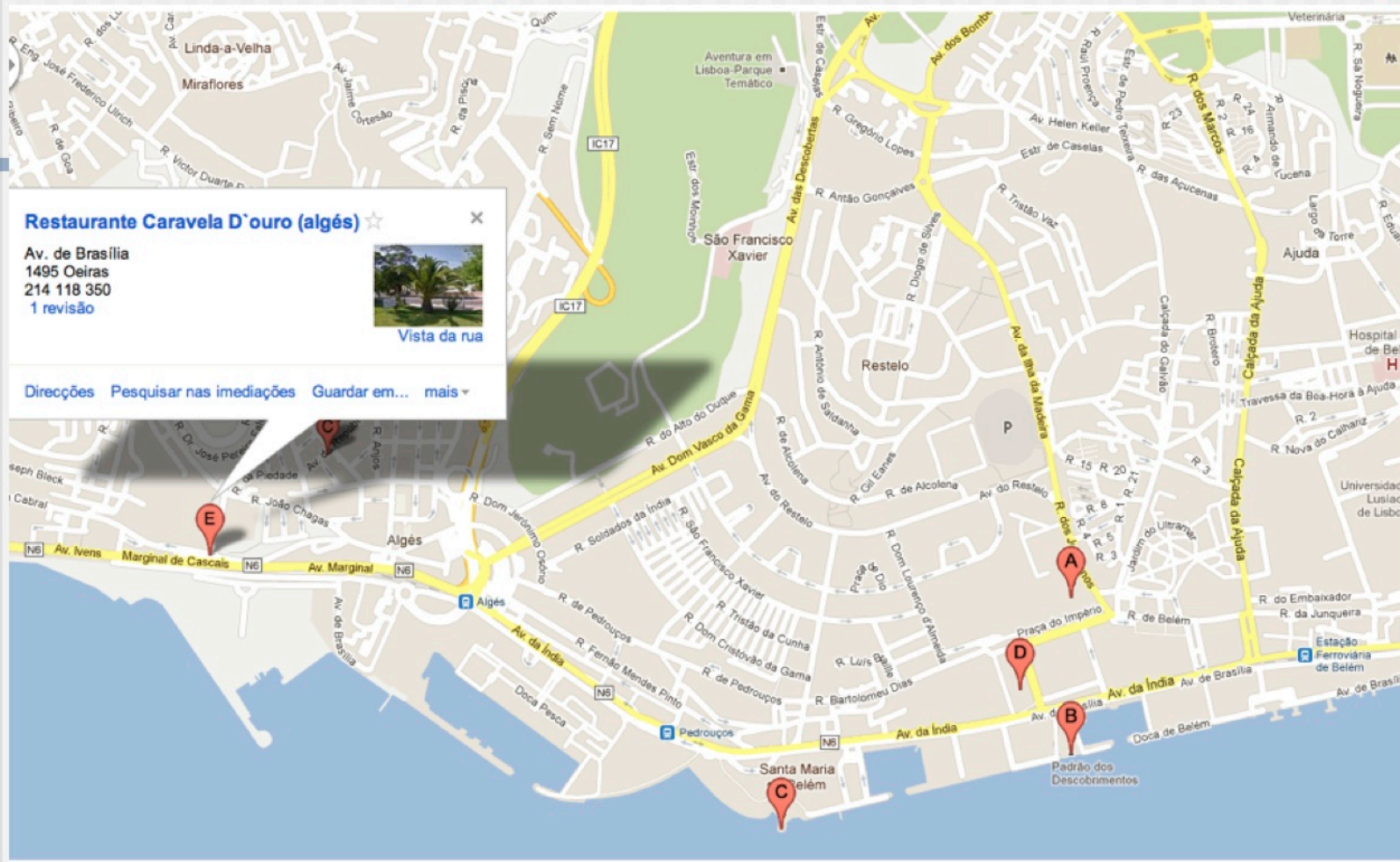
Meeting point
