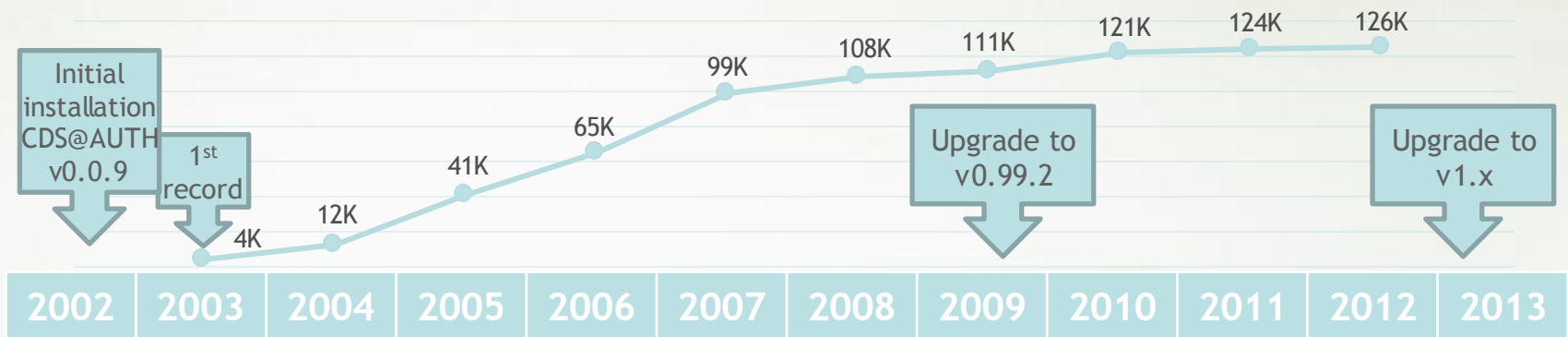

- ❖ Academic Articles, Theses, Old and Rare Books and Manuscripts, Maps, Gravures, Photographs
- ❖ >126k records, 142k pdfs / 2.4m total pages, 330Gb attachments



- ❖ 780.000 visits (500.000 unique) the last 5 years
 - ❖ 90% Greece, 3% Cyprus, 7% others
 - ❖ 62% Google search engine, 16% Library website
 - ❖ Most popular collection: Theses (Graduate/Postgrad/PhD)

Difficulties in our Invenio Installation

- Back in 2003, not the easiest to install (issues with configuration and customization). Not multilingual. Problems with non-Latin characters!
- Upgrade not straightforward for v0.99.2 (1.x upgrade expected to be easier)
- Creation of new collections, customization of forms, creation of extraction templates
- Access rights management
- Customization of statistics
- User-selectable time based release of attachments
- Access restrictions for records and attachments

But thumbs up for:

- 👍 Robustness! NEVER broke badly
- 👍 Very responsive search for the given resources
- 👍 Super customizable
- 👍 Highly helpful and responsive dev team

- Create 'Author profiles', use author IDs and authority records
- Manage users and user roles
- Shibboleth authentication
- Use knowledge bases in search/submit
