



RERO DOC: in summary

- ▶ CDS Invenio v0.99.1
- ▶ 25'943 records
- ▶ Thesis, Dissertations, Books, Newspapers, Journals, Postprints, Preprints, Reports, Maps, Audio Recordings, Music Scores
- ▶ Scientific and Patrimonial documents
- ▶ 45 institutions
- ▶ ~2000 collections



RERO DOC: particularities

- ▶ A lot of institutions
- ▶ A lot of collections
- ▶ Periodicals, newspapers (one bibliographic reference, thousand of full-text files)
- ▶ A mix of scientific and patrimonial content
- ▶ Home developments:
 - ◆ submission module (to be upgraded)
 - ◆ full-text server (migration back to Invenio is planed)
 - ◆ document viewer (<http://www.multivio.org>)
 - ◆ URN persistent identifier assignment

Invenio: thumbs up / down

► We like:

- ◆ python based
- ◆ open source
- ◆ nice guys
- ◆ fast and robust
- ◆ powerful search
- ◆ covers most of our needs

► We don't like:

- ◆ submission interface module
- ◆ frontend appearance difficult to customize
- ◆ sometimes too specific to CERN's needs
- ◆ documentation is scattered
