- Periodicals acquisition : 1500 issues per year

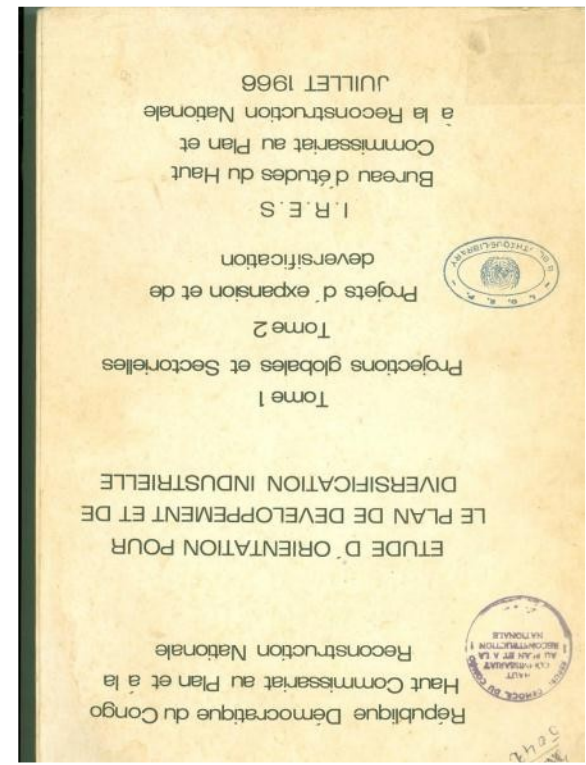

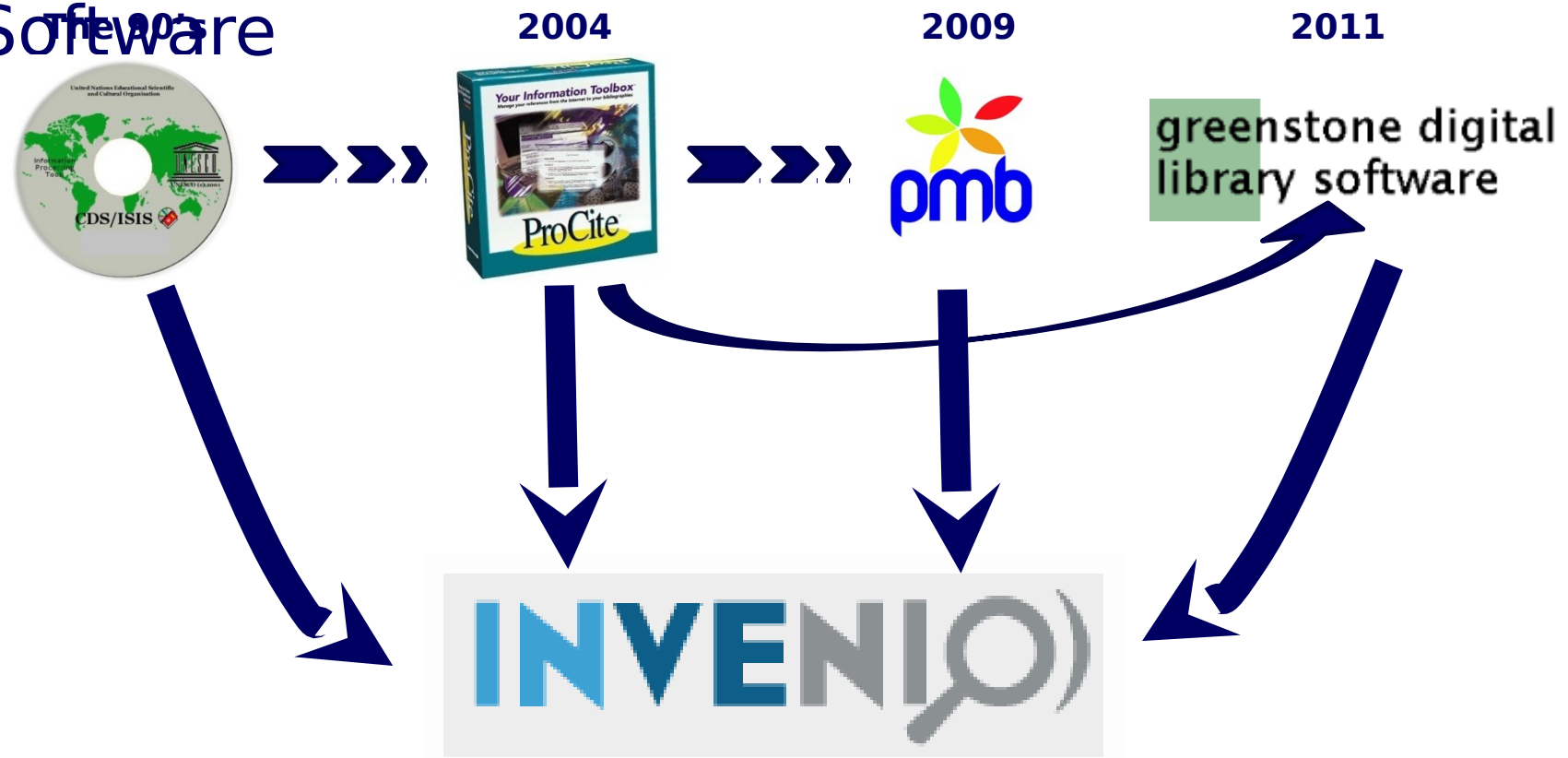

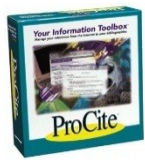
