- Batch submission of new documents from pre-formatted metadata files 
- Patron-driven Acquisition 
- Link of ILL / acquisition with bibliographic records

Expectations: process & curate

- Integration with Indico 
- Schedule batch operations 
- Set Fulltext search 
- Create 'author profiles', use author IDs and authority records 
- Create custom statistics 
- Documentation 

Expectations: dissemination

- Circulation 
- Problems of 'blind' records 
- User Interface configurations 
- User management: better manage users, actions and user roles; combined authentication mechanisms 
- Automate handling of time restricted file 
- Real time access to data via APIs

- Get recommendations and concrete implementation solutions 
- Learn how to extend and optimize 
- Request new features and enhancements 
- Future development plans 
- Contribute back local developments 
- Discover new parts
