

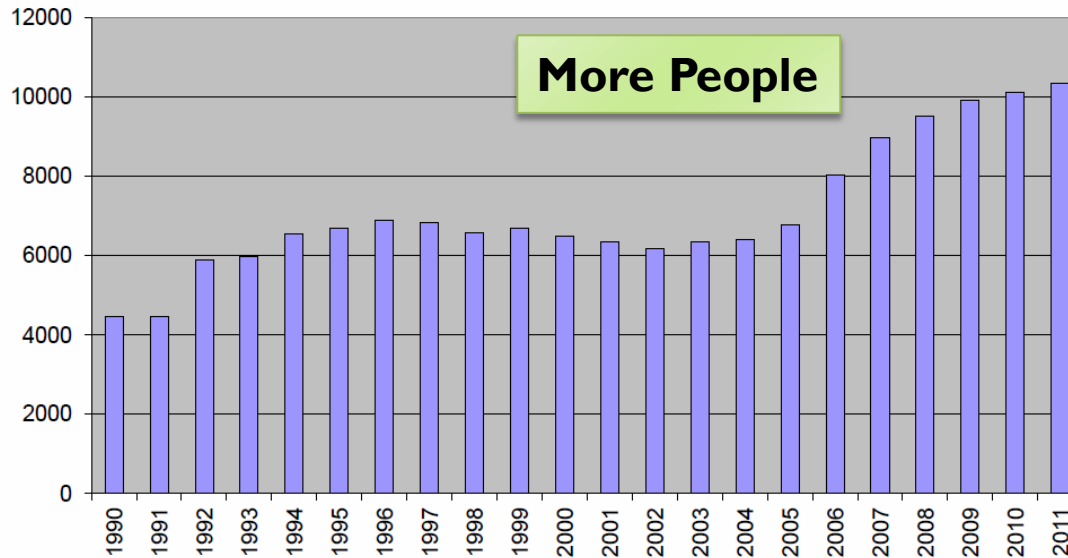

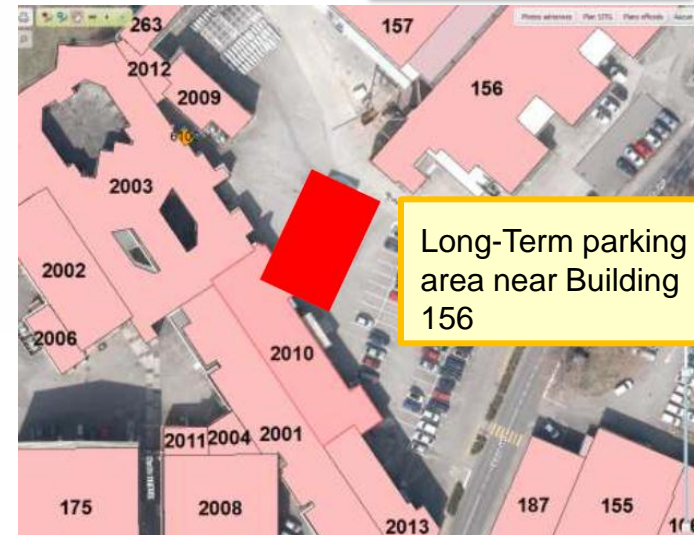

Evolution of number of Users

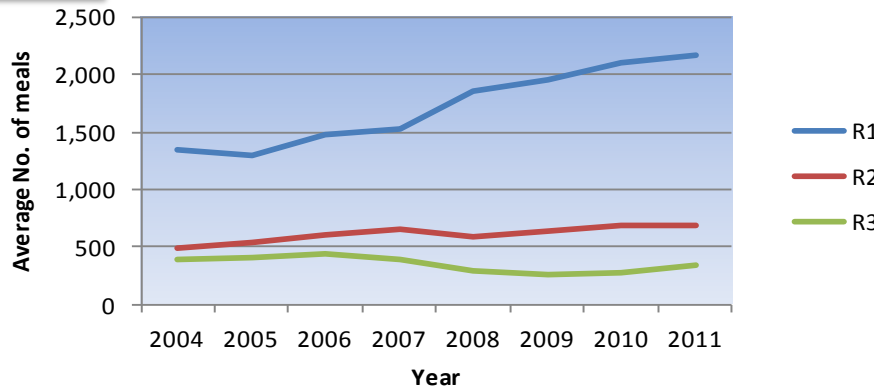


Less Parking

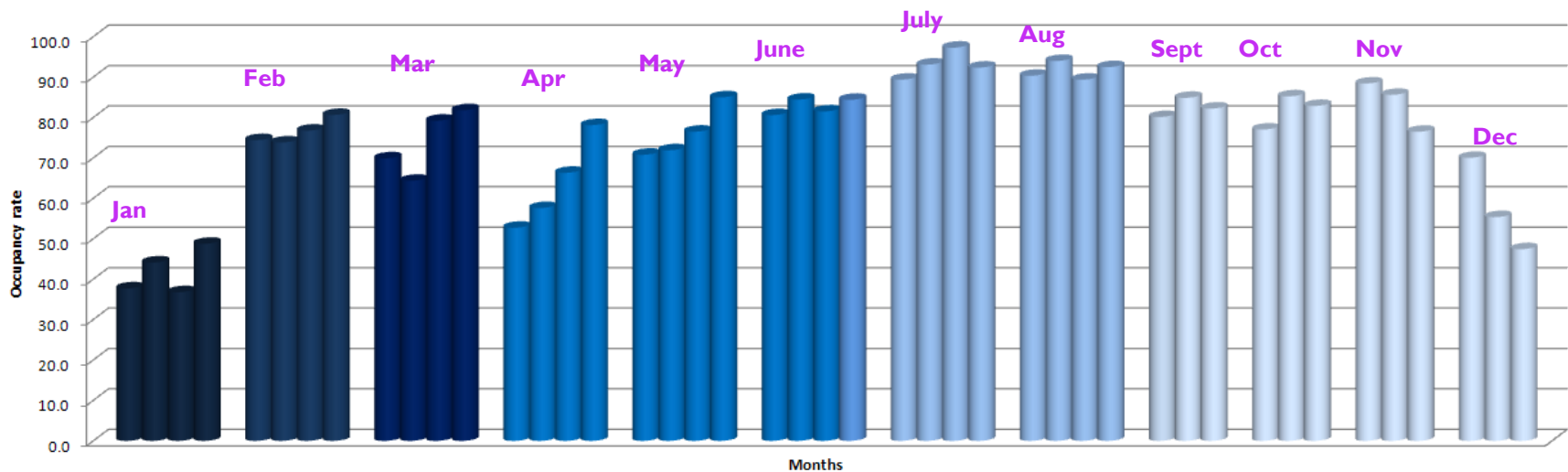

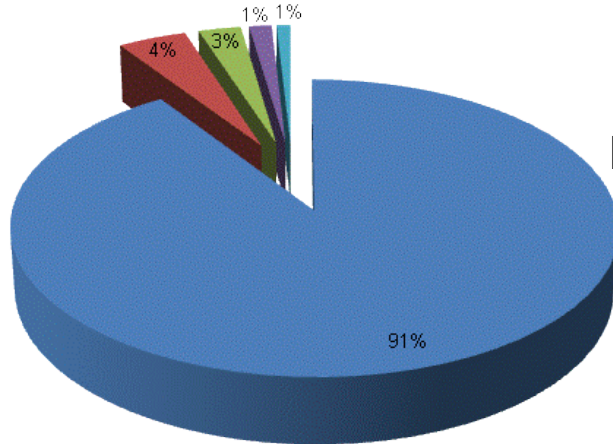
CERN Hotel - Occupancy rates (5 days) 2009,2010, 2011 and Jan-mid Aug. 2012

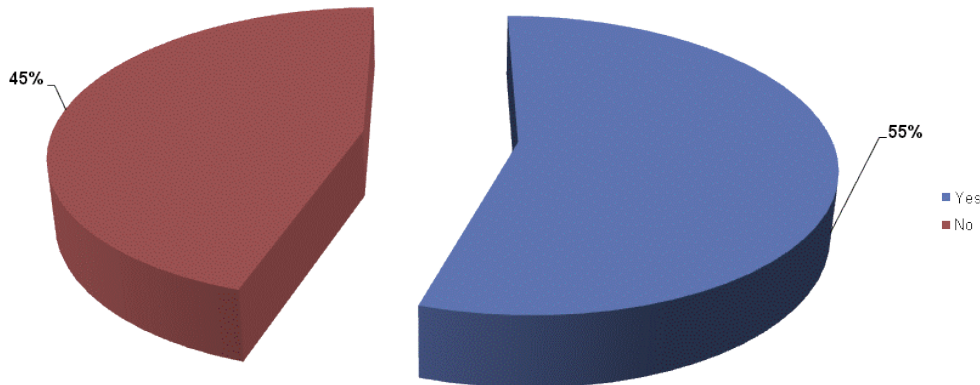

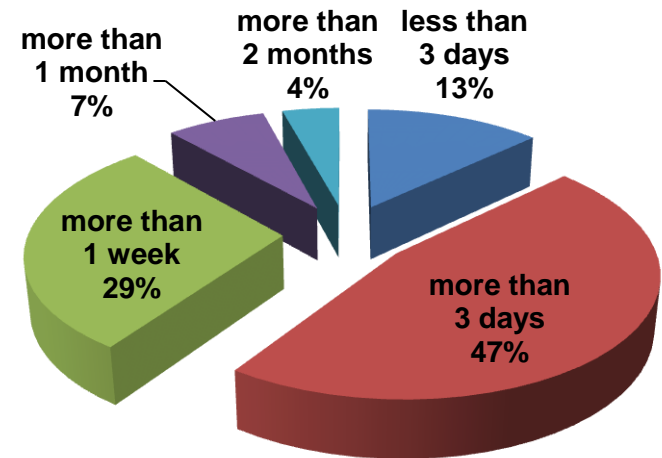

Time of stay (generally)

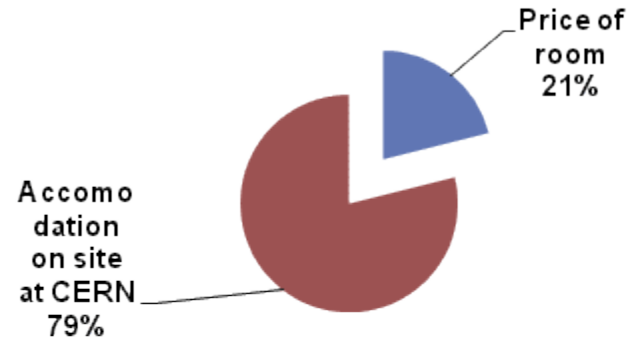

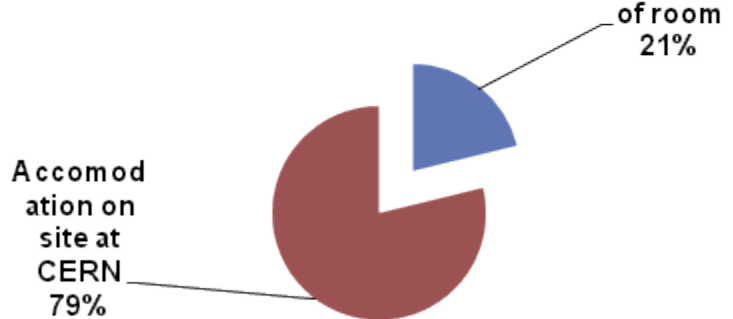
Price VS Comfort

Comfort VS Accommodation

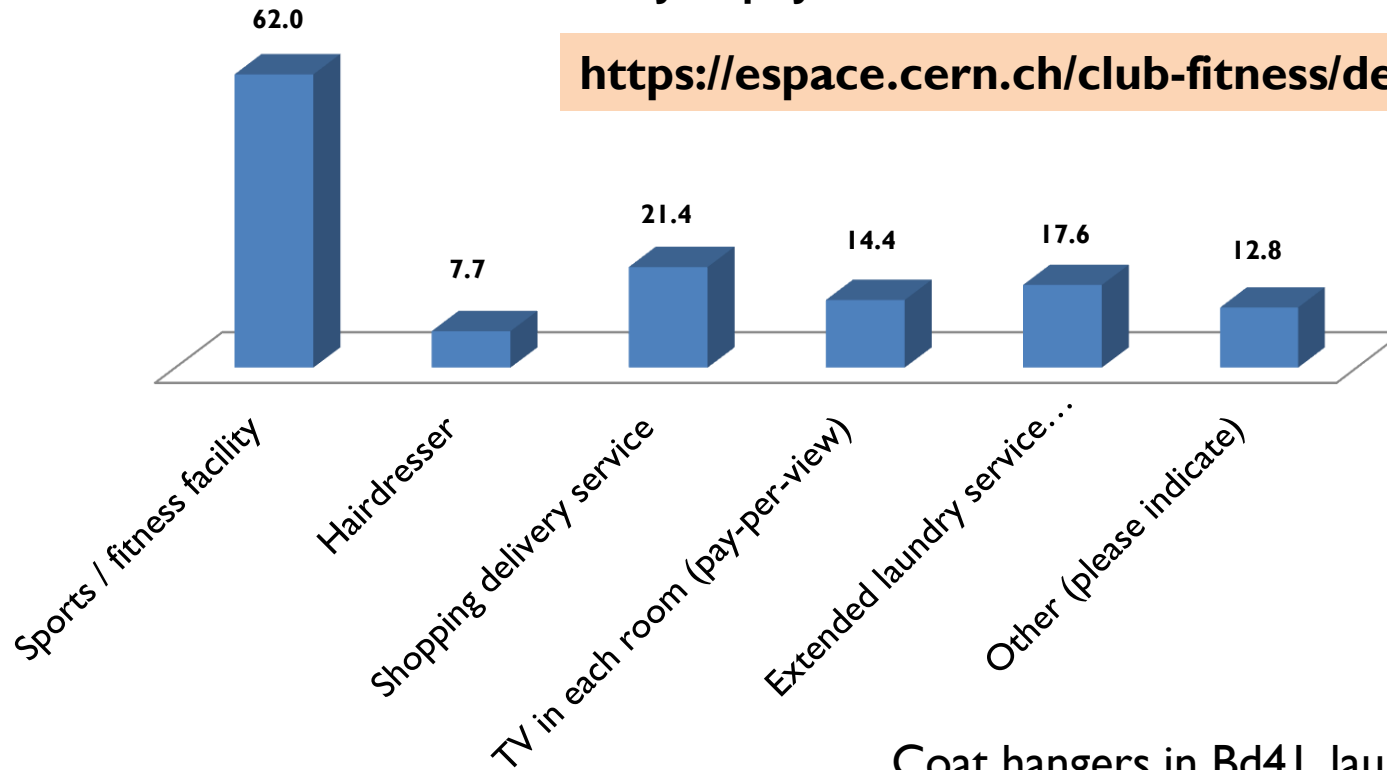

VISA / Schengen

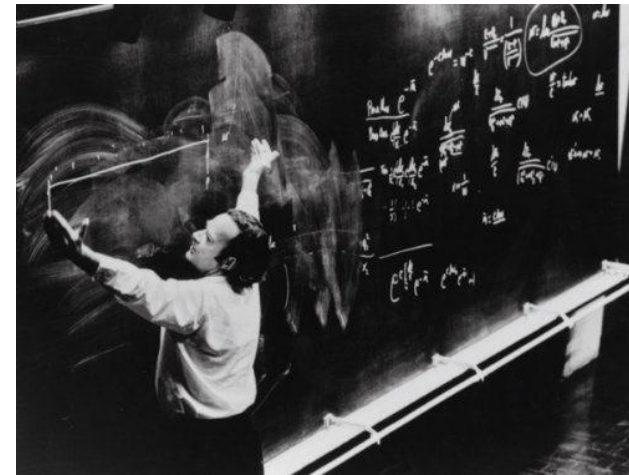
- ▶ In the past, persons subject to visa requirements could ask for both Swiss and French visa before coming to CERN
- ▶ Now only one visa is allowed by the Host States: Both host states refuse granting a visa if the person has already a visa from the other Host State for coming to CERN
- ▶ Users coming to CERN who are subject to visa restrictions **will have to know in advance if they will live in France or in Switzerland** and request the Visa at the corresponding Embassy

Preserving physical heritage

- ▶ There is a policy worked out in 2008 by SIPB
- ▶ “CERN has a scientific and cultural heritage stretching back to the Organization's foundation in 1954 and embodied not only in its scientific works, but also in its scientific instruments and other objects...”
- ▶ Mainly for CERN Departments, but also users can contribute to identify objects
