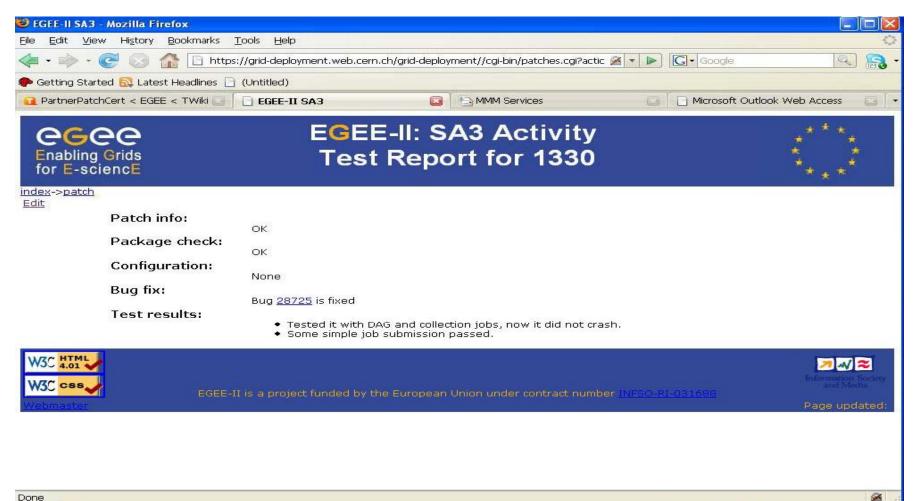

Enabling Grids for E-sciencE

- The first experimental service started at CERN in July last year
- VOs specially ATLAS and CMS were involved in testing
- Developers were involved actively as well
- Moved to INFN this year
- The latest checkpoint release satisfied the acceptance criteria
- Very useful for performance and scalability improvement
- Early involvement of VOs can make the services reaching production quality before certification
