ICC6 Reporting

- ICC6 due on 22 October
- Problem of cumulative aspect of Cost claims:
 - P1 and P2 are separate
 - P1 is closed
 - P2 starts at Q5. All subsequent ICC are cumulative to Q5 and make up P2.
- ICC7 will be due on 22 January
- ICC8 will be due on 22 April or 22 May depending on extension

 MUST book auditors. Too many delays experienced in P1.

FP6 versus FP7

- Cost models AC, FC, FCF Now ALL FC
- Transition rates: 60% or 20% for partners who do not have analytical accounting

FP6 versus FP7

Audit certificates:

- only needed for amounts (cumulative amounts over the two periods) > 375,000 €
- Only 1 audit certificate at the end of the project for those partners
- Can charge average personnel cost (if not too different from reality)
 - Certificate on methodology required
- Can charge permanent staff

EGEE-III, Co-funding schemes and repercussions on reporting

- All academic partners have agreed to provide matching manpower for EGEE-III programme of work
- Assuming the proposal is accepted:
 - Decision required regarding the implementation of co-funding mechanisms during DoW preparation
 - Point of negotiation with EC (Nov/Dec 2007)
 - Currently considering 2 possible schemes:
 - A: 1/2PM funded, 100% reimbursed + 1/2PM unfunded and declared in timesheets.
 - B: All PM funded and 50% reimbursed.
 - Each institute must decide which scheme will be adopted for the duration of the project
 - Repercussions on reporting (Form C complications, supplementary monitoring and reporting)
