# Student Exchange Programme

### **Application Criteria:**

- 1.a short, very clear description of project & aim of visit to host department by WP leader or partner
- 2. letter of acceptance of host project leader, and support for project
- 3. short curriculum vitae
- 4. Estimate of the expected expenses: travel costs based on the cheapest travel fare available, accommodation costs and a per diem in function of the venue/country they will visit
- 5. Submit 2-page report within one month after the stay
- 6. Applications received at least 1 month before the start of the visit
- 7. Visit completed before end of the project, September 2013

Average total amount 1500 Eur or more (negotiable)
