This is the second announcements for the 2nd International Conference on New Frontiers in Physics (ICNFP 2013), which will be held at the OAC Conference Center in Kolymbari, Crete, Greece, from August 28th to September 5th 2013.

We invite both overview and topical talks. The International Conference on New Frontiers in Physics aims to promote scientific exchange and the development of novel ideas, with a particular emphasis on interdisciplinarity. It mainly covers the following topics:

- High Energy Particle Physics
- Heavy Ion Physics
- Quantum Physics, Quantum Entanglement
- Quantum Field Theory, String Theory
- Cosmology, Astrophysics, Gravity
- Mathematical Physics

The conference proceedings will be published in the "European Physical Journal Web of Conferences" following a peer review of contributions.

Conference Fee

The conference fee is:

- 2000 NOK (ca 265 EUR) regular,
- 1400 NOK (ca 185 EUR) student.

The conference fee includes: proceedings, conference dinner, conference excursion, bus transport from and to the Chania airport at the start and end dates of the conference.

Accommodation and OAC conference package

The venue of the conference is OAC – Orthodox Academy of Crete in Kolymbari, Crete, Greece. OAC offers an all-inclusive package which includes accommodation, full board, and conference facilities. The cost per day is:

- 115 Euro per person in a single occupation room
- 90 Euro per person sharing a double room.

For accompanying persons staying in OAC and sharing a double room the cost is 60 Euro per day including accommodation and meals.

In case OAC accommodation is not sufficient to host all participants similar arrangements with two nearby hotels APHEA and LEFKA have been made.

To reserve a room in OAC, APHEA or LEFKA please choose the appropriate option during registration at the conference website.

Note

For participants staying in OAC:

the all-inclusive package has to be paid directly to the OAC.

For participants not staying in OAC:

an **extra payment of 55 EUR pay day** is to be done at the OAC for lunch, dinner, coffee breaks and conference facilities.

Accompanying persons wishing to join the conference dinner and excursion are kindly asked to arrange it at the OAC during registration.

Travel

During the summer period there are many direct flights to Heraklion and Chania from various European cities. **Bus transport will be provided between the Chania airport and OAC at the start and end days of the conference.**

The recommended airport, closest to the conference site, is the Chania International Airport (CHQ). The OAC is located 39 km west from the CHQ airport.

OAC can be reached from the Chania Airport by taxi, public bus, or rental car. The full fare for a taxi, including airport surcharge is around 60 Euros. By bus it is cheaper (line Chania - Castelli), however, the bus stop is located at a distance of about 1 km from the OAC. **The recommended way is taxi or car rental** as special discounts have been arranged (starting from about 26 Euros per day) – please check the conference website for details.

If you decide to fly to Heraklion, you can reach the conference site by taxi (one-way fare around 140 Euros) or by bus from Heraklion to Chania (one bus per hour, line Heraklion-Rethymnon-Chania, duration about three hours) and then to the OAC as explained above.

Please note that the conference takes place during the high tourist season. We strongly advise you to book your flights as soon as possible.

Visa

Greece is within the European Schengen zone, so for EU nationals valid ID card or passport is required.

Non-EU nationals in general require a visa to stay in Greece. A visa is not required for semi-annual visits of up to three months for nationals of those countries for which the European Union has abolished the visa requirement. Nationals of countries which do not have a visa-waiver agreement with the European Union must obtain a visa. For detailed information regarding visas please contact Greek Embassy or Consulate in your country.
