Travel Information

How to get to CERN you may follow this [link](#). Tram 14 takes you from Geneva main station Cornavin to CERN in roughly 20 minutes. The ride is 3.50CHF, a ticket has to be obtained before boarding the tram. Be aware that not all vending machines return change. From Geneva airport, there is a free shuttle service to CERN, see above link for time table.

Access to CERN

If you do not have a CERN ID card, a visitor's pass will be provided. The visitor's pass is to be picked up at the reception (bldg. 33) on weekdays from 9H00 – 17H00. Outside these hours, the visitor's pass is deposited at the main entrance (entrée B).
