- He has been a member of the CERN Research Board and of the Scientific Policy Committee.
- He is a member of the Restricted Panel of the European Committee for Future Accelerators (RECFA).
- He has been Italian Delegate to the Program Committee for the Research Infrastructures of the EU FP6.
- He served in several international panels (DEY PRC, ESFRI, ILCSC, CERN Council Strategy Group).
- He has been Vice President of INFN in the years 2005-2008.
- He is currently Director of Research and Scientific Computing at CERN.
