### **Travel from Dulles Airport to Internet2 DC Office**

- For those arriving at Dulles, taking a Washington Flyer Taxi to the office is your best option. The trip is 30 miles and will cost about \$60.

**Leaving the Airport:** No reservations are necessary. Simply follow the signs for Ground Transportation or Taxi to the lower level of the main terminal where a customer service representative will be available 24 hours a day.

**Coming to the Airport:** Please call 703-572-TAXI (8294) at least 8 hours prior to the desired pick-up time, to place a reservation.

### **Travel from Reagan National Airport to Internet2 Office**

- We are a short, \$15, cab ride from Reagan National.

Taxicabs are dispatched from convenient locations on the arrivals curb just outside the baggage claim areas of each terminal. Uniformed taxicab dispatchers are stationed at each taxicab dispatch area to assist passengers with selecting a taxicab based on destinations in Washington DC, Virginia, or Maryland.

- The Metro is also a convenient option:

Take the Blue Line toward Largo Town Center and get off at the Farragut West Station. Exit the station on 18<sup>th</sup> Street and head north to cross over K, then L Street. We are on the left side, in the middle of the block between L & M Street.

### **Getting TO the Metrorail station FROM the Terminals:**

**Terminal B and C:** Use either of two enclosed pedestrian bridges on the concourse level which connect directly to the station.

**Terminal A:** Exit the terminal to the streetside curb, and board any "Airport Shuttle" bus. At the stops for Terminal B/C or Parking Garages B and C you may access an enclosed bridge which connects to the Metrorail station.

### **Getting TO the Terminals FROM the Metrorail station:**

**Terminal C:** Go to the north end of the train platform and exit the station. A pedestrian bridge connects directly to the Terminal's concourse level.

**Terminal B:** Go to the south end of the train platform and exit the station. A pedestrian bridge connects directly to the Terminal's concourse level.

**Terminal A:** Go to either end of the train platform and exit the station towards the parking garage. Take elevator or stairway down to street level and board any "Airport Shuttle" bus.

## **Travel from Baltimore/Washington International Airport**

### **SuperShuttle**

SuperShuttle is a cost-effective way to travel from BWI to Reagan National Airport. From Reagan, the Internet2 DC Office is a short cab ride away.
