Community within the larger Drupal community to foster:

- networking, knowledge sharing, education and community engagement
- work on collaborative projects

Leverage Economies of Scale
Giving back and making major contributions to Drupal platform



Organizations are Reinventing the Wheel

#### ....behind closed doors

- Creating incompatible solutions to the same problems
- Not releasing these solutions back to the community



Even organizations with the best intentions, the desire to give back, often fail to do so

- Short term focus desire to quickly solve a problem, no time to put in "extra effort" now (at a huge cost later)
- Don't release code b/c they want to add "polish" for release to the public - but never have time to actually do that
- The fear that if you do release something, you won't have the time to support and engage the community after the fact



#### **Members**

- Currently limited to large organizations, "end users" of Drupal
- Exclusive: for companies making a strategic bet on Drupal

#### **Member Networking**

- private events quarterly membership conferences
- peer to peer meet and learn from each other
- local events engage your local community
- global events engage the broader community



**Roles: High Level Overview** 

- Members
   Invitation only; selected by set of (public) criteria
- Staff
   Program & Project Management, Development
- Partners
   Vendors & contractors; selection by (public) criteria
- SponsorsIndividuals, Partners, Foundations, etc.



#### Goals

- Knowledge sharing, education and training networking events, online forums, webinars, white papers, news letters, etc.
- Collaborative Projects
   Identify common problems through member input & feedback
   Anonymize and aggregate common needs, into "Strategic Areas of Interest"



#### **Strategic Areas of Investment**

- Content Authoring
- Mobile
- Content Staging
- Performance & Scalability
- Security
- DEVOPS (Reliable software releases through test, and deployment automation)



#### **Business Case Example:**

Views = module funded by Sony

- Sony could have built views internally they didn't have to release the code
- The community has added millions of dollars worth of enhancements
- Sony NEVER could have created such a system, even if they had invested more money then the community added; a SIGNIFICANTLY great value / system



#### **Future Projects**

Short Term Value, More Projects

- Shift toward smaller (but still meaningful) projects
  - LSD can't afford to do 3 projects like CSI at the same time
  - LSD can afford to do 3 or more smaller projects

Peer to Peer Collaborations

Members also want to work together on their own projects

Community support problem and missing advanced training: LSD can help carbonizing community
