The region is named from the *Umbri* tribe who settled there about in 6th century B.C.

The history of Perugia goes back to the Etruscan period.

It first appears in written history as *Perusia*, one of the twelve confederate cities of Etruria, in about 300 BC.

The city is also known as the universities town, with the University of Perugia founded in 1308 (today about 34,000 students), the University for Foreigners (about 5,000 students), and some smaller colleges such the Academy of Fine Arts "Pietro Vannucci" .

The Institute of Physics was established early seventies and 'Corso di Laurea in Fisica' started in 1978.

High Energy Physics activities (with UA2) started in 1981- 82 thank to Prof. G. Mantovani that from Pavia established in Perugia.

SLD, L3, NA48/62, CMS, BaBar and BELLE2 (Particle Physics)  
AMS, GLAST, VIRGO (Astro-particle) the largest activities.

The **INFN Section of Perugia** was established in 1989 and is located within the Department of Physics of the University with research activities carried out in total symbiosis.

The INFN section employes today 33 staff members (researchers, engineers, technicians and administratives) and about 110 colleagues are associated from the Dep. of Physics and Dep. of Electronics (professors, research associates, post-docs and Ph.D. students).



in **Giò Jazz**.


